Parent Code of Conduct Agreement

In an effort to provide a positive athletic environment, the DeForest Area Girls Youth Basketball Association (DAGYBA) has adopted a Code of Conduct Agreement. As a parent/guardian of a DAGYBA player, I understand the importance of embracing the values of good sportsmanship while demonstrating fairness, respect and self-control by supporting all players, coaches, team managers, referees and parents.

By signing below, I understand and agree to the following:

- I will respect the coaches and demand that my child does the same. If there is an issue I agree to follow the 24-hour rule, which states "no parent in a fit of frustration over a game issue or coaching will contact the coach in any manner until 24 hours has passed." If there is a need for further discussion I agree to file a Coach Concern Form.
- I will respect the officials and their authority during the games and refrain from questioning, discussing or confronting officials during or immediately after a game.
- I will conduct myself in a manner conducive to good sportsmanship by refraining from abusive, obscene or threatening language or gestures of physical violence, and any other behavior that would be considered unsportsmanlike or would disrespect the game, its players, coaches, officials, parents or spectators.
- I will refrain from any behavior which would endanger the health, safety or well-being of any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee.
- I understand that it is my responsibility to respect all equipment, supplies and facilities and to ensure that my child does the same.
- DAGYBA understands that athletes participate in multiple sports and that conflicts are inevitable as seasons wind down and start up. If a conflict arises that will result in a missed practice or tournament, I will communicate this to the coach well in advance of the practice or tournament that will be missed. Upon completion of other sports seasons, I will make every effort to help my daughter honor her commitment to DAGYBA basketball and her team by supporting her attendance at all practices, games and other program events.
- I understand that I am required to perform volunteer duties during the season which include, but are not limited to: selling concessions, running the clock, keeping score sheet and assisting in fundraising.
- I understand that my failure to comply with the DAGYBA Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action that could include, but is not limited to, a verbal or written warning, parental game or season suspension, or permanent expulsion from DAGYBA.
