- 4.1 **President's Report** ~ Jason Johannsen The largest hurdle thus far seems to be website issues, which I plan to address with the league. Cumbersome, not intuitive and no direction. The public schools are instituting the Little Falcons program. Soccer and Cross Country are the pilot programs. There are about 99 kids signed up for soccer and attendance was high the first week. We had a Club banner created (thank you Brendan) to use for promotions. I plan to visit the Complex on the last day of the program and promote the Club. Working with a new deaf interpreter at a much more reasonable rate and schedule. I have also applied for funds to create an interpreter financial account to help offset these costs now and going forward.
- 4.2 **Financial Report** ~ Keith Kramer First round of referee checks went out, looking to do the same for coaches. There will be a full report July, else financials available upon request. Balance good
- 4.3 **Registrar Report** ~ Bill Favro We have added a few players here and there, mainly at U16 and U18. Bill suggested setting up a formal calendar for the year. Include all components of the season. David to take initial stab at calendar
- 4.4 **Coaching Committee Report** ~ Keith Kramer Girl's u18 team is struggling to get players to commit to attend. Jason offered to send a note to Northfield president. Overall happy with coaching and teams. U14 boys are on better footing.
- 4.5 Little Feat/Academy Report ~ Brendan Cox Academy is going well. We have two boys and a girl's team. Mitch Anderson, Krista Cox and Meredith Umbreit are helping. Brita Peterson-Linde plans to help once school is out. Brendan has scheduled some Wednesday friendlies with Northfield for the teams. Little Feat starts Tuesday. Tiny Feat fields are lined, Academy to be lined by Tuesday. Half of the Little Feat coaches assigned, still looking for coaches. Starts at 6:00. Waiting on shirts, won't have them the first week.
- 4.6 **Official's Report** ~ Jason Johannsen Since the first game, we have had full complements of refs for games.
- 4.7 Facilities Report ~ Joe Schleis 4 little feat fields lined. 11yds by 25 yds; Warren/Carlander initially lined. Hispanic League to maintain lines. Hanson mowing doing a nice job, moving goals to mow. Joe weed whipping. Goal weights, should we leave for Carlander/Warren. Suggest doing so until deemed otherwise. Nets are in, being put up. Remaining 4 fields to be lined this week. Check with Paul Penansky regarding ant issue at the center circle.
- 4.8 **Soccer Complex Board** ~ Joe Schleis see email to Paul Penansky, Jason to follow up on expansion plans and adding fields or using the Middle School. Questioned adding Rotary access to 17th street (NW side), mainly for elderly and handicapped. Will also ask Paul Penansky.

- The topic of a defibrillator has been brought up. Do we/should we have one present at the complex? What would be the procedure for that?
- Goal frames. This past weekend I noticed a number of kids climbing on the goal frames to the south of Bahl field, outside the fence. Is this a liability we face if someone were to get hurt? Do we need to consider bringing them inside the fence, or fencing in a small area south of Bahl to secure these?
- Status of fencing between Bahl and Rotary (maybe point above can be added to that initiative (extra 20/30-foot area for frame storage?
