### Q&A: KALEIGH SCHROCK

Kaleigh Schrock, FWAHA Director of Coaching & Development, shares his perspective on hockey development inside the FWAHA.

#### WHY USA HOCKEY'S ADM?

"It's crucial the ADM structure is followed because of its direct correlation with long term athlete development. It creates a pathway to become a better hockey player but more importantly, teaches our kids to be active and healthy and allows them to have fun."

#### HOW IS 8U DEVELOPMENT DIFFERENT THAN 10U+?

"One difference you see at 8U compared to other age levels is the cross ice game play. This is necessary to keep the kids moving and improve their coordination/motor skills before they play full ice. This age level is about having FUN and keeping the kids active."

#### HOW CAN PARENTS SUPPORT PLAYER DEVELOPMENT?

"Parents should be patient with their kids and encourage them. Allow your children to participate in other sports, understanding that a better athlete will lead to a better hockey player. The kids who have the most fun are typically the hardest workers. Do your best to take the pressure off and allow your kid to have fun and reach their full potential."
