- Payments for extra players must be paid on the PF3 website prior to them taking the field
- Players who will only be playing on Sunday must be on the official roster given to the tournament director no later than the Friday June 8th at 8PM MDT

STYLE OF PLAY: 8 Man Eligible Pool Play Tournament

- Saturday's 3 game pool play Saturday for seeding (4 total pool play divisions)
- Top 2 teams from each pool play advance to Pro Single Elimination Tournament on Sunday
- Bottom 2 teams from each pool play placed in Comp Single Elimination Tournament on Sunday

**GAME LENGTH: 20 minute halves** 

OVERTIME (OT): No overtime games in Pool Play

• OT will be in effect for Sunday's Single Elimination Tournaments

MERCY RULE: No Mercy Rule!

WAIVERS: All players must sign the roster/waiver or they will be ineligible to play

UNIFORMS: Teams must have one light, and one dark set of jerseys

• Home team will be required to wear dark jerseys if there is any dispute

FLAG BELTS: Teams must provide own Triple Threat Flags or similar - all belts must be properly sewn on

FOOTBALL: Teams must provide their own football (high school / college / pro)

MINIMUM AGE: Eighteen (18)

AWARDS: 1st place trophy, All Tournament Awards, Championship Game MVP awards

CASH PRIZE: \$200 per team entered and Pro tournament winner takes all. 16 teams = \$3200








PRE-TOURNAMENT RANKING #2






#### PRE-TOURNAMENT RANKING #8


#### KANSAS CITY DNA




#### DENVER ROCKERS



#### **AURORA SPORTS PARK RULES**

& PF3 FINES / SUSPENSIONS FOR NOT COMPLYING

Aurora Sports Park has pointed out the following rules we need to stay on top of this weekend. Failure to comply could put a halt to our tournament, and we could also lose the right to play at Aurora Sports Park in the future. They really protect their fields so we need to do our part!

- NO FIGHTING / NO POLICE CALLS Aurora Sports Park requires us to fill out full names of each individual involved on an incident form. Their field managers are also required to call the police on every incident. Because incidents like these may cause us to lose these fields we are upping the suspensions and fines for those involved. Anyone caught fighting will be suspended from all PF3 events for 2 years, and fined \$500.00! We know this is a long suspension and a heavy fine that will probably never get paid by the individuals who decide to break this rule, but that's ok. If players want to break this rule and cost your teams the chance to play on these fields we don't want them back anyways. This tournament is for those who want to just play the top level of flag football only! There will be plenty of cameras on the field to help us out on this one...
- 2. NO ALCHOHOL OR MARIJUANA ONSITE Although this one may be hard to police, if there is a specific player caught there will be a 1 year suspension and a \$250.00 fine for him. Again, something that could cost us the right to play on these great fields.
- 3. KEEP THE LANGUAGE DOWN because youth games could be going on fields next to our fields. Players who are cursing at an opponent's, official, or tournament staff should be prepared to have their team penalized, sat down for extended amounts of game time, or just completely thrown out of the tournament. The officials may or may not be willing to give them a warning.
- 4. NO FOOD, SEEDS, GUM, OR TABACCO PRODUCTS ON THE TURF! The grassy areas and sidewalks are the only locations this is allowed.
- 5. WATER IS THE ONLY LIQUID ALLOWED ON THE TURF! No Gatorades, Power Aids, Protein Drinks etc. allowed. The grassy areas and sidewalks is the only location liquids other than water is allowed.
- Please help with cleaning up trash after your games.

PLEASE follow these specific rules so we can continue to play at this amazing sports park! If you see someone that is in violation please report it to one of our staff members. Your name will remain anonymous!

Very few tournaments around the country have the ability toplay on fields like these! With everyone's help we can keep these fields and continue to build this tournament!!!




