	If a grievance or misunderstanding between coaches, officials or any other parties arise, I will respectfully communicate through proper channels and procedures.
	I understand that fighting in any capacity will not be tolerated and will have serious consequences for my child.
	I will not use profanity, racial or ethnic slurs, or any other form of offensive language. Nor will I maliciously criticize, badger, harass, or threaten an official, coach, player, or opponent.
	I recognize the value and importance of volunteer coaches and officials, and give them their due respect. Without them, there would not be any youth sports organizations.
	I understand that eligibility requirements, at all levels of the game, must be followed. Rules and requirements such as age, previous level of participation, team transfers, etc have been established to encourage and maximize participation, fair play and to promote safety.
