Neenah Middle School Wrestling Team Rules for Skin Infection Prevention

Daily Shirt Color Policy

Mon-Red

Tue- Gray

Wed-Black

Thurs- White

Fri- Choice

- Wrestlers must shower immediately following any wrestling...no exceptions!!!
- Laundry after every practice/meet
- Wrestling Mats are washed before and after every practice

Neenah Middle School Wrestling Meet Match-Ups

- Middle school meets are organized in a manner to encourage positive live wrestling for the wrestlers. Overall, matches are created to pair wrestlers at similar abilities and weights.
- Weight Class: None. Coaches will keep track of weight throughout the season and send the host school our team roster with weights and abilities ahead of time.
- Ranking: Most host schools ask for rankings on a 5 point scale 5= brand new to wrestling 1= find this wrestler competition.
- Matches: Wrestlers will wrestle three 90 second periods followed by a one minute overtime if necessary.

Neenah Middle School Wrestling Tournament Match-Ups

- Dual team tournaments are structured to send the best wrestler at each
 weight class on the mat. If we have two wrestlers at a specific weight class
 the second wrestler would wrestle if the competing school also has a second
 wrestler (This match would count toward our team score as well).
- Weight Class: Varies based on the tournament. We will ask our athletes to
 wrestle at specific weight classes. It is important that if a wrestler is slotted
 for a weight that they make that weight on the morning of the tournament.
 For example, if the weight class is 95 lbs we would expect that wrestler to
 weigh in at 95.0 or lower (95.1 would result in the athlete having to wrestle
 in the next weight class up). In middle school wrestling we would never ask a
 wrestler to cut any weight, but if they are within a pound of a lower weight
 class we will ask the wrestler and parents which weight class they would
 prefer to wrestle at.







Neenah Middle School Wrestling New Wrestling Parent Guide

- > Practice ends between 5:15 & 5:30 pm unless notified otherwise
- > Dual meets are scheduled to start at 4:15 and will end at 7:30 whether all matches have been completed or not
- ➤ Most meets will have a limited concession stand (snacks and beverages)
- > Typically no entrance fee for spectators to middle school meets
- > Wrestlers are expected to ride the bus to and from all events, if there is a situation where you have to transport the wrestler a waiver form must be filled out
- > You are responsible for your wrestlers food on tournament days (pack a cooler or bring cash)
- > Plan to pay a spectator fee at tournaments

Participation is optional but highly encouraged

Regionals take place at 8 locations in the state of Wisconsin on March 21st (Most wrestlers attend Bayport or Fond du Lac)

Brackets are set by birth year and tournament designated weight classes
