10U Local Travel

New idea - FLEX team - pilot at 10U with coach Steve Heney

■ Steve Heney: Flex / pilot - Hybrid 10U program

Rationale:

 Traditional 10 travel "rigor" seems "too much" for this age group

Goals:

To increase kids in competitive play

To increase current participation in both practices and games

Two practices / week - set day and time

One game / weekend

 Still provide competitive hockey - all players should have done Newbees / House first

No evaluations for this program

No State tournament - possibly attend tournament instead

Host locations for Playdown Weekends have been posted to our website. There is a fine balance between communicating this information in a timely manner and also making sure ice allocations are 100% accurate. At this time I believe this information is ready to be shared with your organizations so families and teams can start planning. Please share with all the right people! It's a lot of information but helpful information.

It is important to note the following:

- *I'm still working on finalizing times with hosts, and will be adding those details to the website next week, but wanted to get locations and weekends out ASAP.
- *There have been some changes to the standings. Teams NOT participating in states will no longer show up in the full list. Teams that have been moved, or divisions combined will also be reflected in the standings.
- *On 1/31 the average (Game Points/Games Played) within the division will be used to determine final State Tournament seedings where needed. It's important that ALL division scores are up to date so your organization doesn't incur a penalty.
- *State Tournament game slots and schedules will get loaded to the website as they become official with final updates on 2/1.
- *Please remember games can be scheduled beginning at 4pm on Friday through 6pm on Sunday (exceptions to this are rare but do happen).
- *Like last year, we'll send an email towards the end of January with instructions on how to confirm your rosters and finalize your credential books. DO NOT make changes to your USA Hockey Roster.
- *Scores need to be up to date. TO AVOID PENALTIES, PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL SCORES HAVE BEEN ENTERED ON THE STATE WEBSITE AND EMAILED TO SCORES@VTHOCKEY.ORG! I don't want to be chasing down missing scores these next two weeks.
- *As we approach the State Tournament, be sure you're familiar with ALL the information, rules & guidelines in the <u>VSAHA Annual Guide</u>. There will be an updated "State Tournament Rules" document posted by the end of this month. Having not read these documents is not an excuse to not abide by them.

Final Home and Home Requirements:

- The goal is ALWAYS Home and Home, this provides 2 games worth of statistics for seeding and reciprocity of travel
- If a game is canceled, specifically due to weather (or COVID), organizations should make their best efforts to reschedule. At this point in the season there is a level of understanding that there are challenges that come with January cancellations. The two teams MUST have at least 1 game and both teams should make a mutual effort on the second game.
- As a reminder, if you have games scheduled the first weekend in February, the scores won't count towards seedings but you are expected to honor those games and they do count towards your required overall game counts!

<u>State Tournament Fees</u> - Invoices will be sent to all the TREASURERS for each team attending States. Fees can be paid online with a credit card OR ACH bank transfer. Fees are still being calculated but will be published before the end of the month.

<u>Credential Books & Stickers</u> - Please make sure coaches are working with local registrars to get team credential books ready for states. It's often helpful for registrars to review with team coaches directly so they know what they need and have. Please be sure all teams have AT LEAST 12 team stickers in their binders. I will repeat, not having read the

state tournament rules is not an excuse to not abide by them.

<u>Tickets</u> - all Playdown locations require attendees to pay a nominal entrance fee. It's helpful to remind all families of this PRIOR to the weekend. Players & Coaches PLAYING at a particular location do not have to pay.

<u>Weather & COVID</u> - two things that have made hockey at times a bit more tricky. While traveling this season for your tournaments please do so safely and be prepared to follow the rules at the host rinks. We will not cancel or reschedule games, it is up to teams to make the right decision for themselves and no shows due to weather or illness will be counted as a forfeit.
