_____ (date). The base-line test can be taken every 2 years.

If an injury should occur and post-concussion testing is sought, the recommendations by Dr. Ward or Dr. Gage for an athlete to return to competitive sports and other activities that have a risk for concussion are being made solely on the basis of the ImPACT Test scores. Dr. Ward and Dr. Gage have not personally examined the athlete and the final determination regarding return to competitive sports should be made by the parents/guardian in consultation with the team athletic trainers and physicians.

When the athlete is registered on the ImPACT Site to take the Test, he/she will be required to submit information which could be used to personally identify him/her. If the athlete registers to take the Test, he/she will also be required to provide ImPACT with information concerning his/her health, including his/her weight, height, current and past treatments and medications, symptoms, and other related medical information. In order for the Test and other aspects of the ImPACT Site to be beneficial to you and operate in the manner they were designed to operate, the athlete must provide Personal Medical Information and Personally Identifiable Information that is accurate and complete.
