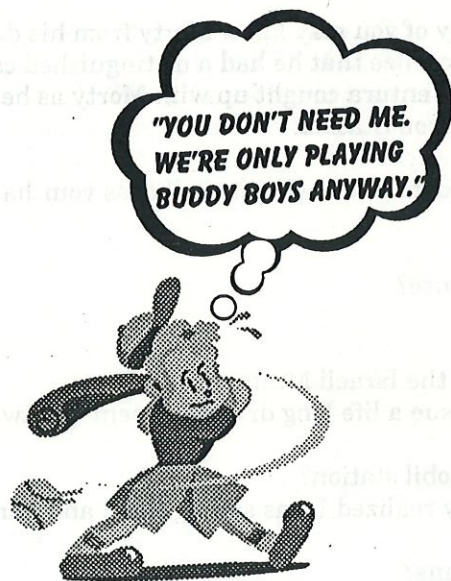
FINAL SCORE: FT - 11 MMD - 7

The Marshall Brothers: Claiming they are being screwed for hits by Daniel's score keeping.

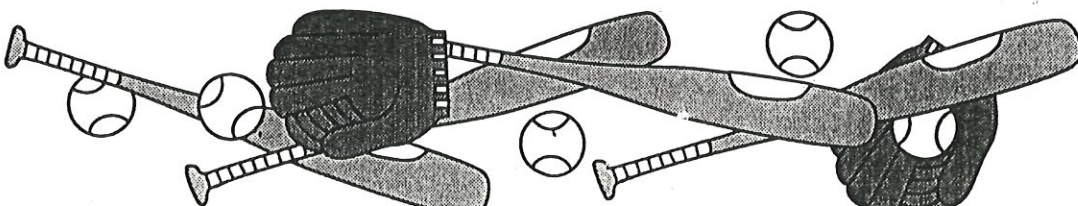
Irwin Azar-Cohen: May have put the bomb in the jersey when he returned it.
