

SHSAA Provincial High School Track & Field Championships June 6 & 7, 2025 Gutheridge Field, Moose Jaw

South Central District is pleased to welcome everyone to the 2025 SHSAA Provincial Track & Field Championship! The following logistics will assist with your preparation. Good Luck!

FACILITY

Gutheridge Field is located next to Riverview Collegiate at 750 Lillooet St W. Please see the map of the entire complex to navigate your arrival.

ADMISSIONS

Admission Gate (Main gate at west end entrance, 2nd gate at Riverview near washrooms)

• Adult Admission: \$8.00 per day

• Student Admission: \$6.00 per day (Grade 7-12)

NOTE: Cash, Debit, and Credit cards will be accepted

Programs

• Available free of charge (one per family) at the Admissions Gate while supplies last.

Parking

- Parking is provided free of charge in the lot west of Gutheridge Field
- Street parking is free on surrounding streets
- Riverview parking lot may be used on Saturday.
- See parking and facility map on the SHSAA website.
- BUS PARKING Will be behind Riverview both days, please keep the Gutheridge Field lot open for cars.

REGISTRATION

• Coaches are asked to send their entire athlete delegation through the registration lines rather than the coaches picking up athlete wristbands for their entire team

Athlete Registration - Friday 7:30 AM - 12:00 PM

- o Athletes and coaches will register in the Riverview gym. Enter Riverview through the main doors on Coteau St.
- O Upon arrival identify yourself by name and district and you will be directed to the proper table to receive a wristband that will allow you to enter the field free of charge.
- o The wristband must be worn the entire meet.
- o Failure to show your admission wristband at the athlete/coach entrance will result in admission being collected at the ticket sales center

Coach Registration - Friday 7:30 AM - 12:00 PM

• Coaches will register in the same manner as the athletes (see times and procedures noted above).

Late Registration - Friday after 12:00 PM | Saturday

Late registration Friday and all registration Saturday will occur at the ticket sales center

MEETINGS

Coaches Meeting

- Saturday, June 7 during the track break
- Meeting will occur in the Riverview gymnasium (enter through west doors)
- District coaches (2 per district) will be provided with free lunch

TRACK & FIELD FACILITY REMINDERS

Track and Infield

- Athletes and Coaches
 - o Only officials are permitted outside the roped off areas on the infield.
 - o Coaches set a good example for our athletes in this regard

Spectators

- o There will be seating areas (roped off) available for spectators at throwing events in the infield
- No spectators, coaches will be allowed inside the fence line at long jump

NOTE: Footballs and frisbees will not be allowed on site for the duration of the event

Walkway in front of the bleachers

• This area is for transit only, spectators may not congregate at the fence line.

Finish Line

• Please keep this area clear while races are underway on the track

Sound booth is available for:

- Coaches/Officials meetings
- Photo finish personnel
- Meet officials and volunteers
- Absolutely no athletes in the sound booth

Tents

- 'Tent village' may surround the entire track, only one tent deep. No tents on the infield.
- Please keep the area clean by putting all garbage into the trash receptacles

Washrooms (3 locations) and changerooms

- Four washrooms are located in the change room at the east end of the track near the high jump. These are not wheelchair accessible washrooms.
- Washrooms are available inside Riverview, access through the east doors near high jump.
- Bert Hunt Arena will be open at the west end of the parking lot, many additional washrooms are in this facility.

Concessions – both days

- The concession run by Riverview Collegiate is located under the sound booth
- Food trucks will provide additional options at the east end of the track.

MEET DETAILS

Marshalling of Athletes

- Field events will be marshalled at the event site. A reminder that the javelin runway at the Moose Jaw facility is a grass surface.
- Track events will be marshalled at the marshalling tent located at the east end of the track in front of the garage.

Medal and Ribbon Presentations

- Field Events
 - O At the conclusion of each field event, the head official will be requested to bring the top competitors $(1^{st} 8^{th})$ to the Awards tent
 - o The head official will give the results sheet to the results runners who will take the sheets to the announcers' booth
 - o Ribbons will be presented to finishers 4 8 while medals will be presented to the top 3
- Track Events

 Within 30 minutes of the conclusion of each track event, the top 8 competitors will be called to the Awards tent and Podium for presentations

NOTE: Please remind your athletes they must wear their District uniform for award presentations

Medical Treatment

- A therapist will be providing care throughout the event. They will be set up inside Riverview, signage will
 provide directions
 - All coaches should equip themselves with standard first-aid supplies including tape, as with any other activity as taping won't be provided.

Schedule and Results

- All event heats/sessions can be found on Athletic Live
- All results will be posted to Athletic Live

NOTE: Athletic Live - Linked to the <u>SHSAA</u> website accessible via QR Code (found at the gate and at various points around the facility)

Merchandise Sales - Sport Logo

Sport Logo will be set up in the garage at the east end of the track

SaskMilk

• All athletes will receive SaskMilk products free of charge throughout the competition. Milk distribution will be located at the awards tent as well as there will be volunteers circulating the facility handing milk out.

ADDITIONAL REMINDERS

- Spectators are allowed on the infield in viewing areas only. There are bleachers to sit on at Gutheridge Field but there is also a hill to sit on which is adjacent to the bleachers. Bring lawn chairs and blankets.
- All throwing events are located on the infield of the track.
- There are three shot put circles at the west end of the track. All quad events will be using these circles.
- Athletes will have areas sectioned off that they need to stay in while competing. Coaches will not be allowed in these areas, but they can come and speak with their athletes outside of the roped off area.
- Footballs, frisbees, etc. are not allowed.
