Jean- need some help here. We have two girls living in Windsor that would like to play on our Girls 14U AAA team. Before beginning any dialogue with them, I wanted to get clarification on the rule. Page 27 (f) talks to out of state players.

(f) Teams can not have more than 3 out of state or import players (ex. 1 import+ 2 out of State=Max number allowed). Import player is an out of state player that lives in Michigan with a Michigan address whose parents have assigned guardianship to a family in Michigan. Import players must produce documentation from school/district they are attending.

So my read is that we could place them on our Compuware team. I think all we would need is the Canadian Citizens Transfer form. Am I missing something?
