Guidelines for Synthetic Turf Field Use

- **WATER ONLY**
Consumption of Sport Drink, Soda, Coffee **NOT PERMITTED**
- **NO FOOD**
Under no circumstance is food allowed on the playing surface.
This includes: Gum, Fruit, Sunflower Seeds, etc.
- Players, Coaches, Officials **ONLY** permitted inside the fence.
Parents, Spectators are **NOT PERMITTED** on the playing surface.
- **NO PETS**
- Players, Coaches, Officials are **NOT** to jump the fence.
 - Fence jumping will result in removal from Field/Park.
 - Gated entrances are the only entrance/exit point on field.
- Coaches/Managers are to ensure cleanup of field is done after use.
 - It is the responsibility of the Coaches to clean up their bench areas.
- Coaches/Managers participating in the final game of their league schedule are responsible for his/her team breaking down the field. This includes:
 - Cleaning up trash
 - Moving player benches against inside of fence
 - Lacrosse Coaches must move goals off field into corners and lock where required. Goals should **NOT** be thrown over fence.
 - Picking up Field Cones, placing in designated Job-Box
 - Removing table/chair/scoreboard/clock/horn, etc., placing in designated Job-Box
 - Ensure that Job-Box is locked (youth leagues) and secure, field is clear of all game equipment and debris
