

Once again, many of our goals were accomplished by outstanding depth. 29 wrestlers were used on the Varsity throughout the season, in order to achieve our accomplishments. This year's motto **"TEAM FIRST"** could not have come at a better time, as we had to continue to plug new wrestlers into the line – up, due to sickness and injury. The team put everything together at the Regional, winning the championship for the 3<sup>rd</sup> consecutive season. The Tigers had 8 sectional qualifiers, and half of those (4) made it to the State tournament. Matt Kent's individual success at the state tournament was an awesome achievement to witness, as he went a grueling 5-1 to take 3<sup>rd</sup> place, tying him for second best all time in Edwardsville History. The team's accomplishments were a direct reflection of the hard practices, off season work, and the will to get better. Wrestling is a very demanding sport that makes it difficult to continue strong. Those that have continued strong are part of an elite group of – Tiger Wrestlers. The ability to endure a wrestling season can help make you strong in life, and overcome other tough situations. I admire the commitment that these young men have made this season, and I look forward to being even more proud as they continue to make important decisions in the future.

I thought last year's squad had a very large number of seniors. (9) But this year's team was even larger, as we had 12 senior wrestlers and two senior stat girls. 
