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Thank you for volunteering to be your team safety officer. We appreciate your willingness to help!

## **Team Safety Officer Role:**

As the team safety officer, it is your responsibility to ensure that our teams are abiding by our league safety protocols. You are also the link between your team and the league Safety Officer if we have any health/safety concerns.

### **Key Responsibilities:**

#### 1. Health screenings

We need to screen every player and coach at every practice. This involves doing a quick visual wellness check, taking temperatures & having each player answer the verbal questionnaire. The league will provide a thermometer for you. Details on our health screening process can be found here:

#### 2. Sanitize hands (players and coaches) when entering and exiting the field.

#### 3. Enforce mask wearing On and OFF the field.
