

OTHS BOOSTER CLUB MEETING

June 12, 2024

President Tiffany Ditchfield called the meeting to order with 15 members in attendance. A motion to approve the minutes from the May 2024 meeting was made by Courtney Miller and seconded by Stacey Soulsby. Correspondence consisting of thank you notes from scholarship recipients and coaches was read by the secretary. The May treasurer's report was reviewed. A motion to approve the report was made by Carrie Price and seconded by Courtney Miller.

Administrative Reports

Membership (Stacey Soulsby) No update.

Website (Ellen Gross) The website will be updated by July 1, 2024, with 2024-25 dates and membership information.

Scholarship (Carrie Price) The committee awarded a total of \$8,000

Golf Outing (Mike Jaegle) Tiffany reported that there will be no golf outing this year due to a lack of available dates.

Athletic Director's Report Mr. Leslie reported that Spring sports have concluded. Boys tennis and track both had athletes qualify for State competition. Historically, Booster Club has reimbursed \$25 per athlete per day for meal expenses while at State. A total of \$175 was requested and will be reimbursed to the OTHS athletic department (Track - \$75 for one athlete, three days; Tennis - \$100 for two athletes, two days).

Booster club recently funded a request for new racks and benches for the weightroom. That equipment has already been installed and put to immediate use. Approximately 80-90 athletes per day have been participating in summer weightlifting, and that new equipment has been critical.

Mr. Leslie noted that the existing OTHS Athletics social media accounts are personally connected to retiring AD Mike Cooper. New accounts will be created, and Mr. Leslie requested the assistance of the Booster Club and members in spreading the word when the time comes.

Sports physicals will be offered at OTHS again, as in the past, in cooperation with OSF. The date will be announced soon. Parents' night for fall athletes will be held the week of August 12.

Old Business

Bowling Alley sign Amy Brenbarger reported that Tim Trumbo will repaint the sign.

New Business

Officer Nominations Officer elections were held. A motion to approve the slate of officers as listed on the meeting agenda was made by Carrie Price and seconded by Stacey Soulsby. The motion was unanimously approved.

Pirates Chest (Courtney Miller and Carrie Price) The Pirates Chest drawing will be rebranded this year as a cash raffle. Details, including the cost of tickets and the amount to be raffled, have yet to be finalized.

Courtneye and Carrie will meet with a committee of interested Booster Club members over the summer and share specific details when we meet again in August.

A motion to adjourn was made by Devon Henson and seconded by Amy Brenbarger.

The next meeting will be held Wednesday, August 14, at 7 p.m. Reminder that there is no July meeting.
