

Procedures for Adult Tournaments (2023-24 Season)

Here are the procedures for adult BB/B tournaments.

Rosters/Sign-in Sheets

- The adults do not have/use rosters.
- All participants must sign the sign-in sheet. This is administered by the Tournament Director. At the captain's meeting for the first 2 or 3 matches (when there is a 10-minute warmup), remind the captains that all players must sign-in before playing.
- If a Juniors team is playing, remind the coaches that the coaches must sign the sign-in sheet and that the Tournament Director will verify the Junior players (similar to what is done at Junior tournaments).

Warm-ups

- 10-minutes shared for first 2-3 matches (first time a team plays)
- 5 minutes shared for remaining matches

Switching Sides

- Per the USAV rules, there are no switching sides unless there is a clear advantage as determined by the Tournament Director.
- Teams will remain on one side of the court for the duration of the match. If a deciding game is played, teams will not switch sides.

Game Balls

- The Tournament Director provides Molten FLISTATEC balls, when available.

Uniforms/Libero/Captains

- The rules for uniforms are relaxed.
- The only requirement relates to the Libero uniform. If a team uses a Libero, the shirt worn by Libero must be easily identifiable by the referee. Confirm who is the Libero at the start of the set.
- As there are no uniform numbers required, there are no line-up sheets. Confirm who is the floor captain.

Work Teams/Scoring

- The work team will supply an R2, two (2) line judges, and one flipper.
- A scoresheet is NOT used; the final score for each set (and timeouts) are entered onto the Match Sheet. Remind the flipper that they must write the score after each set is complete and they must write the timeouts taken by each team.
- The flipper should also write in the teams that are playing and the work team name.
- The Libero tracking sheet is not used.

Scoresheets/Match Sheets

- Scoresheets are not used during the matches.
- Line-up sheets are not used during the matches.
- As a result, the teams end up with unlimited substitutions.
- There is a Match Sheet provided to capture the scores for each set. The work team must write in the team names (playing and work), the scores for each set, and timeouts.
- At the end of the match, the captains confirm that the recorded scores are correct, and the referee (R1) also signs to confirm that the captains signed.
