 - Short videos that can be done with minimal equipment, about 15 mins. Kids watch and do and then answer some questions about it so they understand what they did and why
 - Partnering w/ them just means directly sending the app to the skaters. Players pay only \$9.99 then.
 - Easily affordable and accessible for all skaters so they can help develop at home, on their own.
 - No cost for association to be a partner
 - Coaches get free membership so they can connect w/ players. He creates a code for them; they just need to sign up. Also a Goalie track for free, lessons for at home, mindset, recovery, hockey IQ. Players make their own account too, but 9.95/mth. for life of membership. 2 siblings could share it but only track one results
