Juniors Tournament Information & FAQs

Check-In

Please be sure to arrive at least 30mins prior to the start time listed below for team Check-In. This will allow us time to make adjustments in the pool schedule if teams don't show and for you to warm-up prior to playing. Since most people are new to sand volleyball, we will also cover the rules of the game at this time. Please do not be late for team check-in.

Payment

Cost is \$30/player, Coed \$20/player, please bring cash or check (made out to C2 Attack Beach) to the check-in.

Uniforms

Per collegiate sand volleyball rules, the uniform top <u>must cover the mid-drift</u> but we allow players and parents to choose their athletes' uniforms - spandex/shorts or bikini top/bottoms. Uniforms do not have to match at all...just come ready to play. ©

Amenities & Food/Drink

Sports*Com has 4 beautiful sand courts, is adjacent to a 50-meter outdoor pool with water slide. There is plenty of room for your canopies, lawn chairs & a great place for the entire family. Be sure to bring your own food & drinks, etc. (water, Gatorade, orange slices). There are absolutely no glass bottles allowed anywhere near the court. Parents and players we ask that you help us keep the premises clean as we found it when arriving.

What to Bring

- Food & drinks for your family & maybe to share ☺
- Bathing suits & towels (if you want to go in the pool/water park)
- Sunscreen (and lots of it)
- Lawn chairs (trust me you'll want to sit down), blankets & tents/canopies for shade
- Sunglasses and/or a hat (the sun is bright & your retinas are the only ones you get for life)

Format

Pool Play games for seeding followed by a single or double elimination tournament depending on time. Large divisions may have a Gold/Silver tournament while smaller divisions will just have a single bracket. Prizes awarded to the winners.

Can I play both days of the weekend?

Absolutely! This is why we set up our tournaments with 2 separate days – we want kids playing "up" an age division or playing with adults in the Co-Ed division on Sundays. Many of our top 14yr old players will play 16U on Saturday and 14U on Sundays. Our top older kids will play 16U or 18U on Saturday and then compete in the Co-Ed division on Sunday. The more you play, the better you become.
