

Rhineland Ice Association Hockey - COVID 19 Policies

General Information:

STAY HOME WHEN SICK OR IF DIRECTLY EXPOSED TO COVID-19.

DO NOT COME TO PRACTICE OR A GAME IF YOU HAVE ANY COVID-19 SYMPTOMS OR OTHER ILLNESS.

DO NOT COME TO PRACTICE OR A GAME IF YOU HAVE HAD CLOSE CONTACT WITH ANYONE CONFIRMED WITH COVID-19 WITHIN THE PAST 2 WEEKS.

DO NOT COME TO PRACTICE OR A GAME IF YOU HAVE A 100.4 FEVER OR HIGHER (EVEN IF YOU HAVE NO OTHER SYMPTOMS).

PLEASE SELF MONITOR YOUR FAMILY FOR ILLNESS AND/OR SYMPTOMS.

Participation in any Rhineland Ice Association On-Ice or Off-ice activity by you or your child constitutes agreement of this document, the below risks, and the below rules. You (parent) and any participants must (1) comply with the COVID-19 policy, (2) Assume all risks of transmission and complications of COVID-19, and (3) Release and hold harmless the Rhineland Ice Association and its home ice facilities from all liability and losses arising from your participation and your child's participation in activities organized, hosted, sponsored or participated in by Rhineland Ice Association. Furthermore, you understand no refunds will be issued due to quarantine requirements, or if a team has to cancel games due to not having enough players to participate for any reason.

RULES as of 11/20/2020

- 1. All entrants into the rink will be required to wear masks at all times. This includes coaches, players, and any parents/spectators.**
2. Entrance will be the main south entrance doors. Exit will be the west concession doors.
3. Skaters must bring their own water bottles.
4. Parents are required to keep players who are sick at home. Coaches will have the authority to send kids home if the child comes to the rink with symptoms of illness. Anyone with signs or symptoms of illness must not enter the facility. Parents must notify the Rink Manager of any positive tests in a player's household.
- 5. Players must arrive at the rink dressed. They may enter the rink 10 minutes before practice time. No locker rooms will be used. Hockey bags and extra items shall not be brought into the rink.** There will be a designating area seating for players to put their skates on. This area will be located in the concession area closest to the entrance. The rink entrance near the bleachers/main doors will be the entrance used to gain access to the ice. Once practice is done, the team on the ice will get off the ice on the players bench side of the rink, and remove their skates in the concession area near the concession windows and exit the rink within 10 minutes. A designated volunteer will disinfect the seating area and other touch

surfaces immediately before players enter the rink, and immediately before the players exit the ice surface.

6. The off ice training area will be available only on a scheduled basis organized by a coach. A limit of 8 participants and 1 coach may be present in the area at a time.

7. **PARENT / SPECTATOR POLICIES FOR PRACTICE** - Mite/Learn to Play participants shall come dressed but will be allowed one parent or other designated individual to enter the building with them and assist in tying skates, etc. This parent may remain in the building - in the bleacher area socially distanced from others. Squirt participants shall come dressed but will be allowed one parent or other designated individual to enter the building to assist in tying skates, etc. This person shall leave the rink until practice is over, and may return to help remove skates etc. Peewee through Bantam participants shall come dressed and no parent will be allowed in the building for these practices. There will be a designated area for skate tying. If your skater is unable to tie their own skates, etc - please purchase a pair of skate guards and tie them prior to entering the building. Goalkeepers should do their best to follow this policy, but we realize they may need to put leg pads or chest pads on at the rink.

8. **RESTROOMS** - Although the main lobby restrooms will be available, we ask that they only be used on an emergency basis.
