KHL Goals:

KHL is staffed by a volunteer Board of Directors, coaches, parents, and others, who are committed to providing an enriching and challenging program through teamwork, respect, discipline, and a lifelong appreciation of the game of hockey. KHL defines success as continual player development through active participation in the sport of hockey, while building sportsmanship and character. Hockey activities are designed to meet the needs of all levels of youth, with progressive and challenging programs as they move up age divisions.

Hockey Gear & Skate Sharpening:

Full gear is required for all players, whether in LTS/LTP or registered for a full season. Starter gear for 5-8 year olds is available for first-year KHL players, who are brand new to hockey. Gear bags include a helmet and all necessary pads. They are available mid-October for \$25.00 and \$150.00 deposit. *Please note: players must provide their own skates and sticks*.

Required Hockey Gear: Helmet with face shield, chest protector, elbow pads, hockey gloves, padded hockey pants, shin pads, hockey skates, hockey stick, mouth guard (required for 12U and up, highly recommended for all ages), KHL game jerseys, KHL practice jerseys, KHL game socks, KHL practice sock, highly recommended: neck guard, athletic cup.

Uniforms: game jerseys & game socks \$130/set and practice jerseys & practice socks \$60/set. If you still need your jerseys or need to confirm your jersey number, contact your Team Manager. Once confirmed, Bases Loaded will print your player's last name and number on the jersey for a fee (around \$30.00). **Skate Sharpening:** Young players can get their hockey skates sharpened every 2-4 weeks, or 20-30 hours of ice time. If you push hard on your edges, you'll want it done more often. This time-frame is only to give you an idea; it would be best to sharpen your skates whenever you feel like it's affecting your game. Skate sharpening is available through the city, drop off & pick-up at the Teen Center: If you drop off your skates Monday - Thursday between 2:00pm – 8:00pm, your skates will be ready for pick up the next day, in the afternoon. Any skates dropped off Friday - Sunday will be available for pick-up Monday afternoon. Prices for skate sharpening: \$7 per pair or \$60 for a 10 - punch card.
