

## 2021 Carolina Amateur Hockey Association Championship Tournament COVID Protocols NORTH CAROLINA

All teams must follow the current local and state COVID-19 guidelines and the CAHA COVID-19 policy. These include:

**NORTH CAROLINA** - all current NC state guidelines and CAHA COVID guidelines need to be followed which includes players wearing masks on the ice, on the bench, and any time during team activities at the rink or in any other location.

- Only 1 spectator per player is allowed in the building. All spectators must enter through the same door that their team enters.
- There will be separate entrances for Home and Visitor teams.
- Spectators must have a temperature check, wear a mask, and check-in with the Annex staff before entering.
- Teams may enter no more than 45 minutes before game time.
- Spectators may enter no more than 15 minutes before game time.
- All players, coaches, spectators must exit via the side Exits.
- MASKS are required at all times including on the ice for players, on the benches for coaches, and in the penalty boxes for penalty box attendants.
- EJECTION penalty will be enforced by referees and Tournament Director for any coach or player not wearing a mask as required. Zero Tolerance and no warnings will be given. Game will be stopped and player or coach will be removed. This is a Tournament rule and does not require an additional 1-game suspension.
- MAXIMUM 3 non-players on the bench includes coaches, photographers, or injured players.
- MAXIMUM of 1 Penalty Box attendant per penalty box
- NO handshake lines. For Championship Games, teams will line up on their respective blue lines and each player will step forward when their name is called. Medals will be given to the coach to distribute to their players.
- NO Spectators on the ice or benches after the game.
- 1 Team photographer allowed on the bench after the game for team pictures.
- Teams must leave the locker rooms and building within 15 minutes after the end of their game.

## Annex Guests,

As a reminder, each player is allowed 1 spectator.

- Each spectator and player must wear a mask at all times. The only exception to this mandate is when a player has to adjust their mask on the ice.
- Each person must enter through the front door, get their temperature taken and answer the questions by an Annex employee.
- Coaches, scorekeepers, penalty box assistants do not count towards the 1 spectator per player. <u>They must be on the list sent over by the team manager.</u>
- Children under the age of 7 are allowed to come in with an adult. They must remain seated, not running around the building and be wearing a mask.

We want to be as accommodating to all spectators but at the same time keeping everyone safe and following Governor Cooper's mandate of 25 people indoors for a game.
