### 1. Current Finances (Anderson):

#### a. Coach Payments:

- i. Two coaches volunteering this year; will need to budget \$2600 more next year for an additional paid coach
- ii. Will pay coaches tonight; \$9600 total this year for coaching
- iii. Taxes are done; Adam to review and Mary will file

### 2. Fundraising/Sponsorships:

- a. Sponsorships for banner reviewed and spreadsheet updated
- b. **Cub bagging:** Sunday 3/16, have open shifts for this, especially third shift. Mentor leaders to message their groups.
- c. **Inver Grove Brewing:** was on 2/25; Alli will find out how much we raised
- d. **Yard signs:** have sold 18 so far; discussed buying extra to sell at Scrimmage Fest, team dinners and maybe some games
- e. **Double Good Popcorn:** Julie presented an opportunity to raise money selling popcorn. LV Girls Hockey raised \$5000/4 days this year. Sell online, ships directly to buyer. No minimum and keep 50% of sales.
- f. **Upcoming Fundraisers:** Las Tortillas 4/9, Omni 4/14, Jersey Mike's 5/17 and 5/18

### 3. Team Dinners:

- a. **Ole Piper:** wants to donate; will ask them to do 5/6 dinner since this one is not on a Monday
- b. **Sign-ups:** coming soon, will need to plan food for 80 people
- c. **Supplies:** Adam and Caryn have some; Mary will order what else we need.
- d. Caryn working on assigning mentor groups to bring food and work each dinner except the 5/6 dinner.

### 4. Scrimmage Fest April 5<sup>th</sup>:

- a. Volunteer sign-ups coming
- b. **Concessions:** Want to sell water and Gatorade, will sell from 10am-5pm
- c. **Food Truck:** Ol' Smoky BBQ truck will be there selling food from 10:30am-1pm
