Who is Eligible

Boys and girls 3-6 years of age and have an interest in skating and hockey. Skaters are encouraged to remain in the program as long as possible prior to starting 1st grade. As each child is unique, only the parent will be able to assess when their child has the independence and physical development to enroll. However, we have had tremendous success with kids beginning the program at age 3-4 and continuing to age 6.

Gear

Have your skater wear loose fitting clothing, don't overdress them, they will get hot

Required:

- Helmet with cage or face shield
- Skates – available for rent at the MAC, additional fee
- Hockey gloves or mittens
- Elbow pads
- Shin guards

Optional:

- Hockey Stick (can help cut on the 1st day if needed)
