Last Chance Lacrosse Club (LCLC) Coach Application Form COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT

As a coach of the **Last Chance Lacrosse Club (LCLC)**, I understand that my responsibilities as a high school coach carry great importance and that my actions significantly influence the athletes I coach. Therefore, I promise to uphold the following **Coach's Code of Conduct**.

Professional Conduct and Responsibility

- I will conduct myself in accordance with this Code of Conduct at all times, understanding that there will be consequences if I fail to do so.
- I will treat each athlete, opposing coach, parent, and official with **respect and dignity**, regardless of race, creed, color, sex, or ability.
- I will be **on time** for all practices, games, and team functions.
- I will prepare and implement **structured**, **skill-based**, **and organized practice plans** that emphasize fundamentals, teamwork, fitness, and citizenship—ensuring that all athletes have the opportunity to learn and improve through active participation.

Integrity and Sportsmanship

- I will uphold the **authority of officials** and assist them in conducting fair and impartial contests.
- I will cooperate fully with the league in enforcing rules and regulations, and I will report all suspected violations of any rules, regulations, or policies.
- I will not use profanity or abusive language.
- I will not use drugs or alcohol while at any league, club, or school event, and I will not coach, officiate, or participate in any event while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- I will not transport any children other than my own to or from any LCLC or **Montana High School** Lacrosse Association (MHSLA) activity or event.
- I will not encourage or allow players, parents, or spectators to initiate arguments, fights, or confrontations with any coach, parent, player, official, or attendee.
- I will not engage in **verbal or physical threats, abuse, or unsportsmanlike conduct** toward any coach, parent, player, official, or spectator.
- I will not encourage or tolerate any behavior that could endanger the health, safety, or well-being of any individual.
- I will not, nor will I allow parents, guardians, or spectators affiliated with my team to **yell at or verbally** assault officials before, during, or after any game.

Compliance and Qualifications

- I will complete and maintain all coaching requirements as determined by the club and the league, including but not limited to:
 - PCA Double-Goal Coach Course completion
 - US Lacrosse Level 1 Online Coaches Course completion
 - Passing a league-certified background check
 - Maintaining league-mandated memberships
 - Meeting all certification deadlines and renewal dates

Disciplinary Actions

I understand that if I fail to abide by this Code of Conduct, I may be subject to disciplinary action, which may include, but is not limited to:

- 1. Verbal warning from an official, head coach, club representative, or league official
- 2. Written warning from LCLC and/or the league
- 3. Suspension or immediate ejection from a game by an official, LCLC, or the league
- 4. Game forfeiture through decision of an official or coach
- 5. Suspension from coaching in the MHSLA

Return to coaching after a suspension will be subject to current MHSLA and LCLC rules.

Documentation

I understand that documentation of all incidents and disciplinary actions will be kept on file by all organizations involved.

Expectations of Coaches:

- Have an open line of communication between the coaches and the Last Chance Lacrosse Board of Directors (BOD).
- Head coaches attend board meetings
- If attendance in person is not possible, assistant coaches can attend and represent the head coach. If neither head or assistant coaches can attend, it is expected that this is communicated with the board president prior to the meetings and
 - Make the BOD aware of any disciplinary action with an athlete.
 - Direct any parent or athlete to submit any grievance they may have to the LCLC BOD.
