Biggest issue with the summer was the lack of umpires. The baseball committee needs help. There are a few people doing the majority of the work.

Fastpitch

2021 recap

- The season started in January for Soderville Fastpitch with large group training for each age level and an inaugural domeball league for 10U.
- During the Summer we fielded 3 teams at 10U, 2 teams at 12U, and 2 teams in 14U. Our teams played in many tournaments - mostly local, with a few playing as far away as lowa and Rockford IL. We has four teams participate in the North NAFA Nationals, and 1 team participate in the Midwest NAFA Nationals.
- Soderville Fastpitch once again hosted a local 8U league which offered a Slammin' 8s tournament as well as an end of season tournament.
- We received some coach, team, and program feedback and made changes or had conversations when warranted.
- Moving into Fall we had 2 teams at 10U, two teams at 12U, and 2 at 14U, and 1 at 16U. It was
 a quick 5 week program wrapping up with a Fall State tournament. I know of 2 teams that
 won their tier bracket, and most others had a decent showing at their State Tournament.
- We ended the 2021 season 9 days ago with our end of season tryouts for the 2022 season. Currently we are in the process of identifying coaches - which will be quickly followed by team formation so that off season training can begin.

Off-season

- Approved to run a 10U domeball league once again thru the NSC. Preliminary schedule would be 5 weeks of doubleheaders in Sundays starting February 13th and running thru March 20th. They would be 1 hour games starting at 1PM. Next step is to reachout to surround communities to find 3 more organizations that would like to take part in the league. Will also need to align umpires.(cost will be \$1,500 per team)
- WIII once again offer large group training at Complete Game starting the 1st week of January and running thru the end of March. 14U+ will meet 9 times, 12U and 10U will meet 10 times (SBAA cost will be \$4,500)
