- ALL PLAYERS ARE EXPECTED TO HAVE THEIR OWN EQUIPMENT (HELMETS, MOUTHGUARDS, STICKS, SHOULDER PADS, ARM GUARDS, GLOVES, CLEATS, ETC)
- HELMETS (BLACK CASCADE S - REQUIRED FOR JV AND VARSITY) OTHER HELMET COLORS ARE OKAY FOR THE 9th GRADE TEAM.
 - WE STRONGLY ENCOURAGE ALL PLAYERS TO HAVE THE OFFICIAL TEAM HELMET
- PLAYERS WILL BE EVALUATED BASED ON LACROSSE FUNDAMENTALS (CATCHING, THROWING, SHOOTING, PASSING, ETC), ATHLETIC ABILITY (SPEED, STRENGTH & ENDURANCE), FIELD AWARENESS AND LACROSSE IQ, EFFORT AND OTHER INTANGIBLES.
- ALL PLAYERS WILL BE GIVEN A FAIR OPPORTUNITY TO MAKE TEAMS.
- EACH PLAYER WILL MEET WITH THE COACHING STAFF TO LEARN WHAT TEAM HE MADE AND WILL BE GIVEN AN ASSESSMENT OF THEIR TRYOUT. THIS WILL HAPPEN ON THE THIRD DAY OF TRYOUTS, NEAR THE END OF THE TRYOUT SESSION.

2021 ROYALS HELMETS

- EVERY 3 YEARS OUR PROGRAM REQUIRES NEW HELMETS. NEW HELMETS WERE PURCHASED FOR 2020.
- WE HAVE MOVED FROM THE CASCADE-R (WHITE HELMETS) TO THE NEW CASCADE-S (BLACK HELMETS)
- THIS IS DONE FOR SAFETY REASONS AND TO MAKE IT EASILY IDENTIFIABLE FOR US THAT PLAYERS DO HAVE NEW HELMETS.

TEAM FORMATION

- **VARSITY:** 20-23 PLAYERS
 - **JUNIOR VARSITY:** 20-23 PLAYERS
 - **9th GRADE TEAM:** 18-22 PLAYERS
 - SLIGHT CHANGE TO THE PREP TEAMS THIS YEAR IN DISTRICT 833.
 - NOW KNOWN AS OR REFERRED TO AS, “9th GRADE TEAM”.
 - ONLY 9th and 8th GRADE STUDENT ATHLETES ARE ELIGIBLE.
 - **PLAYER MOVEMENT:** WE DO OUR BEST TO PLACE PLAYERS ACCURATELY AT TRYOUTS, HOWEVER, THE TEAM YOU START ON MAY NOT BE THE TEAM YOU END THE SEASON WITH.
 - WE GENERAL HAVE ABOUT 3-5 PLAYERS THAT SWING BETWEEN JV AND VARSITY. PER MSHSL RULES, A STUDENT ATHLETE MAY PLAY UP TO 6 QUARTERS OF LACROSSE PER GAME DAY.
 - THESE NUMBERS & TEAMS WILL FLUCTUATE DEPENDING ON HOW MANY BOYS REGISTER TO PLAY.

TEAM APPAREL ORDER

- EACH SEASON THE BOOSTER CLUB ORGANIZES A ROYALS LACROSSE APPAREL ORDER.
- EAST SIDE LACROSSE IS THE VENDOR HANDLING THE ORDER.
- ORDERING THIS APPAREL IS OPTIONAL AND NOT REQUIRED.
 - OUR RECOMMENDED APPAREL ITEMS ARE HIGHLIGHTED IN THE TEAM STORE OR IN A PLAYER PACK.
- **THE TEAM STORE IS CURRENTLY OPEN AND WILL CLOSE ON SUNDAY FEBRUARY 14th. ALL ORDERS MUST BE PLACED DURING THIS TIME.**
 - LEAD TIME IS 4-6 WEEKS, SO APPAREL SHOULD ARRIVE JUST IN TIME FOR THE START OF THE SEASON.
 - APPAREL WILL BE SHIPPED DIRECTLY TO HOMES OR CAN BE PICKED UP AT EAST SIDE LACROSSE.

- THESE EXPECTATIONS WILL BE DISCUSSED IN DETAIL WITH THE PLAYERS AT A PLAYERS/COACHES MEETING THE WEEK OF MARCH 29th.
- TO BE MINDFUL AND TO PRIORITIZE THE IMPORTANCE OF OUR COVID PROTOCOLS AT ALL TIMES. ONE WRONG DECISION COULD DERAIL OUR ENTIRE SEASON
- FOLLOW MSHSL AND WHS RULES PROHIBITING THE USE OF DRUGS, ALCOHOL AND TOBACCO FOR THE ENTIRE YEAR.
- MAINTAIN GOOD ACADEMIC STANDING, 2.0 GPA OR HIGHER. THE ACTIVITIES OFFICE WILL BE PROACTIVE IN NOTIFYING THE COACHING STAFF IF A PLAYER IS FALLING BEHIND IN THIS ASPECT.
- BE RESPECTFUL OF OTHERS.
- BE RESPECTFUL OF SCHOOL AND TEAM PROPERTY.
- BE RESPONSIBLE AND ACCOUNTABLE, INCLUDING BEING **ON TIME** FOR EVERYTHING.


RIGHTS OF THE PARENTS

 - TO DISCUSS LACROSSE RELATED CONCERNS WITH THE COACHING STAFF **24 HOURS** AFTER A GAME OR PRACTICE.
 - TO KNOW THE CHAIN OF COMMUNICATION TO DISCUSS ANY OTHER ISSUES. (SON, COACH, ACTIVITIES DIRECTOR, PRINCIPAL)
