MEETING MINUTES Monday, October 9, 2017

II. BACKPACKS

- Backpacks will not be purchased by Booster Club this year. Captains can add backpacks to apparel order for those girls that would like to purchase them. Sharon sent info from last year with company name to Gabby Rosenthal.

III. AD CAMPAIGN

- Ad campaign moving but not at the rate it should be. Reminder that girls are able to defray Grand Rapids and apparel costs if they sell ads.
- Jennifer Argeros is keeping the book with order forms.
- An email was sent out last week by Lisa Explaining Senior Ads and Good Luck Lines.

IV. BYHA

- Sherry rec'd email stating BYHA was matching the donation from last year. Sherry will send a thank you note to BYHA.
- BYHA is still looking at senior scholarships for next year.
- We had good participation at the hockey sign ups and pre-skates. BYHA 'Taste of Hockey' attendance from the girls was non-existent.

V. VOLUNTEERING

- Toys for Tots is set up by Guider and it's typically on the last Sunday of the Toys for Tots campaign. No parents are needed for volunteers at this event.
- Feed My Starving Children – set up by a parent typically in the past. Feedback from last year is to NOT have it be so late and try to get it right after practice (with enough time to eat dinner).

VI. SCRIMMAGE FEST

- Four schools participate in the scrimmage fest (both JV and V for each team).
- Guider will put signs on locker rooms for each team. Since Guider is there early we don't need a 'greeter' volunteer to tell teams where they are going.
- Boosters will arrange for table between rinks with food and drink.

VI. BLITZ NIGHT

- 6 pm on 11/6 for girls to turn in cookie dough / treat orders and \$\$
- Girls turn in \$\$ and parent group helps with counting to ensure all money and item totals are accurate.
- Since the girls have a month to sell their 35 items they typically don't need to go out and sell on 'blitz night.'
- Guider will ask Suhon about 'buy out' option for cookie dough / treats.
- If girls go above and beyond selling 40 items or greater, they may receive locker bags that Guider has seen at SCSU (instead of a sweatshirt or other apparel).

VII. COACHES REPORT

- Guider needs data from flash drives if girls can bring him what they have.
- Changes were made to the game schedule and Guider has updated the website to reflect these changes.

- Guider will check with Penny to determine if Fridays are an option for lifting. The only caveat is doing lifting the day before a game since most Saturdays we have games.
- Guider will let us know what Mondays would work for Yoga in January so that Lisa can arrange with Jean Clauer. Yoga will be on Fridays most of the season?
- Sharon will send Guider the updated parent checklist for the booster section of the website.
- Sponsor section of the website needs to be updated.
- Guider will send Sharon the forms that were given to the players to send to parents.
- Boosters will present their items at beginning of parent meeting on 10/24.
- Need to only order ½ of the programs that were ordered last year.
- New jerseys aren't in yet.
- Special nights (i.e. Youth night) have been added to the calendar on the website.
