Wednesday, October 18, 2023 at 6:30 pm

The regular meeting of the Tea Park and Recreation Board was held on Wednesday, September 20, 2023 at 6:30pm at Tea City Hall. Board members present were: John Ganschow, Vicki Pick, Jeff Portner, Curt Hauff, & Hallie Munoz. Chaired by Brian Headrick. Also present: Jake Kerr

-Motion made by Portner and Seconded by Munoz to add Adult Basketball to agenda item 6-C, and to approve the current agenda after adding that agenda item. Ayes, all in favor. Motion carried.

-Motion made by Portner Seconded by Ganschow to approve the September 20, 2023 Tea Park and Recreation Board Minutes. Ayes, all in favor. Motion Carried.

RECREATION REPORT

- Headrick provided an update on Flag Football. The last day of flag football was on Saturday, October 7.

- Hauff & Kerr provided an update on fall soccer. The last day of Pre-K-2nd Grade Soccer was on Saturday, October 7. 3rd-6th grade soccer is still currently going on with DASC. Hauff did voice his concern in field space for soccer practices for 3rd-6th grade due to the new baseball/softball field being built. Kerr also brought up to give 3rd graders soccer balls since they now use size 4 soccer balls instead of size 3. To offset those cost anyone in pre-k that registered in fall soccer would not get a soccer ball for spring soccer.

- Kerr provided an update on youth basketball. Currently have 89 participants registered. That program will start on Saturday, October 28 Tea Venture Elementary.

- Kerr provided an update on Adult Co-Ed Volleyball. Currently have completed 6 weeks of regular season games thus far.

- Ganschow provided an updated on our meeting with Harrisburg for 8U and 10U Softball.

- The board had a discussion on travel baseball and softball teams registering through Tea Parks and Rec. There was no motion on at the end of this discussion.

- Kerr provided an update on youth indoor soccer program. They currently have dates set for January 13, 20, 27, & February 3. February 10 is a make up date if necessary. Kerr will start to work on the registration for this program.
