All Participants/Parents shall abide by the understated CCYF Code of Conduct.

I hereby pledge/agree to:

- Not force my child to participate in sports.
- Remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for children and not for adults.
- Learn the rules of the game and policies of CCYF.
- That myself and my guests will be a positive role model for my child and encourage good sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, by demonstrating positive support for players, cheerleaders, coaches, officials, board members, volunteers and spectators at every game, practice, or any other CCYF event.
- That myself and my guests will not engage in any kind of un-sportsman-like behavior/conduct such as booing, taunting, using profanity, or profane gestures.
- Teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve any conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- Teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game or his/her performance.
- Never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- Emphasize that skill development is learned at practices and how they benefit my child. I also understand not attending practices may affect my child's playing time.
- Respect the officials and their authority during games and will never question or discuss their judgements at the game field. I understand that I may become an official by joining the local association.
- Demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol, and refrain from their use at all CCYF events.
- Refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one of the official coaches of the team.
- Refrain from disrespecting any player, coach, administrator, opponent, or referee in any social media and will not post any pictures or names in social media.
- Be a good citizen and do my best at school.
- Use only safety equipment issued or approved by CCYF.
- Any/all personal equipment must meet National Federation High School sports standards and be approved by a CCYF Board Member.
- That ALL CCYF equipment must be cleaned and returned on specified date and time.
- Demand that myself, my child and guests, treat other players, officials, board members, volunteers, and spectators with respect regardless of race, sexual orientation, creed, or ability.
