TOURNAMENT DETAILS

1. REGISTRATION DEADLINE is November 20th.
2. ENTRY FEE is \$300 per team for all grade levels. Returning teams will receive a \$25 discount. Each team is guaranteed 3 games.
3. ROSTER FORM must be submitted prior to November 20th. Coaches must be able to produce copies of birth certificates, if requested. Once the tournament begins, there can be no roster changes.
4. Brackets will be finalized on November 22nd.

Only games canceled due to weather will be rescheduled.

5. Shoot 360 will provide referees.
6. Players can play up in grade, but never down in grade.
7. No player can play for more than one team at any grade level unless prior approval has been granted by the Tournament Director.
8. All Team Members and Fans must comply with the policies of Shoot 360 Pittsburgh during the games.
9. DAILY ADMISSIONS: \$5 per adult; \$3 per student; no charge for children under age 5.

Each team will be permitted free admission for 1 Head Coach and 1 Assistant Coach. Each team must supply a scorekeeper for every game. Coaches must be designated on the roster form.

No drinks other than water and sports drinks are permitted in the gym. NO food is allowed in the gym. Shoot 360 will have water and Gatorade for sale on premises.

TOURNAMENT RULES

- Normal basketball rules apply.
- Players must be in the same school district.
- Two 18-minute halves with a running clock except last 2 minutes of each half.
- 1st overtime will be 2 minutes - running clock the first 1 minute and will stop on all whistles the final minute of overtime. If a 2nd OT is needed it will be sudden death.
- In the final 2 minutes of the game, if either team is leading by 15 points or more, the clock will not stop.
- Time Outs: 2 timeouts per half - one full & one :30. In the event of overtime, each team will receive an additional :30 timeout.
- Each team will be responsible for supplying a person to keep the scorebook.
- Five-minute grace period exists. Teams must be on the floor ready to play no later than 5 minutes after the scheduled starting time, or a forfeit may be called by the Tournament Director.
- All players must wear numbered jerseys.
- Uniform numbers can wait until the first game, if not yet known at the time of application.

BASKETBALL SIZE

- 5th grade will use a 28.5" ball.
- 6th-7th grade will use an official ball (29.5").

TIE BREAKERS

- Head-to-Head
- Point Differential-Maximum 15 Points
- PA - Points Allowed
- PS - Points Scored
- LAD - Last Actual Differential
- Coin Flip
