

# White Bear Lake Hockey Tournaments

## SCORE TABLE INFORMATION

### PLEASE READ ALL THE WAY THROUGH BEFORE YOUR SHIFT BEGINS!!

POINT PEOPLE WILL BE ON SITE. CONTACT THEM FIRST FOR IMMEDIATE ON SITE CONCERNS.

- 5 minute warm up before games. NO WARM-UPS after resurfacing!!! Refs MUST enforce this to stay on time!
- Confirm that you have all your supplies: stickered scorebook, pens, microphone, game pucks, rules, program, etc.
- PeeWee AA, all Bantam and Jr. Gold games will be resurfaced every 2 periods. All other levels will be resurfaced at the end of each game.
- 6 goal lead in the 3rd period will dictate running time until the lead is reduced to less than 6 goals.
- Each team is allowed ONE 1 minute time-out during regulation play.
- Announce starting lineups when time permits (not during pool play if applicable). Extra lineup sheets are at the welcome desk.
- ANNOUNCE GOALS, ASSISTS, PENALTIES! HAVE FUN! THE CROWDS LOVE IT!
- GAME SCORE SHEETS- White copy stays in the book. PINK/YELLOW/GOLD need to be brought to the welcome desk immediately following the game for the coaches/managers to pick up.
- After the last game of the day make sure scorebooks, pucks, puck buckets, all supplies, etc. are all brought back up to the welcome desk to be stored for the night/weekend.

### GAME ANNOUNCER

*"Good (Morning/ Afternoon/ Evening)...Welcome to the (YEAR) WBL Moose Goheen OR Jeffrey Hayne Tournament.*

### CHAMPIONSHIP SUNDAY:

- Make sure you have the Bear Trophies and medals (if applicable) at the score table **before the game**. At game end, ask both teams to line up on the blue lines. Congratulate both teams on a great tournament.
- Bracket tournaments have trophies for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and Consolation Champion. Pool tournaments have trophies for 1st, 2nd and 3rd.
- Announce each individual player and present the trophies and medals (if applicable) to the players.
- Ask the team captains to please come forward to accept their \_\_\_\_\_ place trophy.
