Anne:

Lighting update Mr. Camp has declined all our offers and we are continuing to put money into the Capital fund a month. We are also contacting the CABC attorney for advice on the situation.

Mr. Hedin has a court appearance May 31, 2022 and his attorney has been updated on the additional charges brought against him.

Middle school fall sports registration will open June 1, 2022 via family ID, Sports engine registration for participation fees will be after tryouts and the team rosters have been made.

Assistance for Family ID registration will be available on the field and via email.

Fundraising for the CABC middle school sports will be in the hands of the coaches and all team fundraisers funds will stay with the team in an account under the specific team.

Additional items the coaches and team would like will come from these funds

If they sign on a sponsorship the cost of the banners will come out of the sponsorship and the rest will be placed in the account. Parents will most likely help when it is specifically for their child's team.

A committee will have a list of business contacts so we are not contacting them more than once.

We are encouraging the teams to go to businesses that they use.

Dine outs will be ran through the CABC as a non profit as some franchises require.

We are looking at more ways for the CMS and CHS athletes to interact and work as a team
