

WILD CARD DETERMINATIONS

The following steps will be taken to determine the Wild Card team(s).

STEP 1: NUMBER OF WINS

Number of wins in all Pool Play games will be the first determining factor for the wild card berths.

- **STEP 2:** If **two teams** are tied with the same number of wins, the following steps will be taken to determine the Wild Card(s):
 - A) **HEAD-TO-HEAD** competition will be the first tie-breaker in any situation when applicable.
 - B) **LEAST RUNS ALLOWED** will be used. All pool play games will be counted. If still tied, refer to *C*.
 - C) **MOST RUNS SCORED** will be used. All pool play games will be counted.
- **STEP 3:** If two or more teams are tied with the same number of wins the following steps will be taken to determine the Wild Card(s):
 - A) **LEAST RUNS ALLOWED** will be used. All pool play games will be counted. The teams with the lowest runs allowed will be awarded the remaining wild card berths.

If more than two teams are still tied, see Step 4.

Refer to Step 2 if there are two teams that remain tied after completing Step 3.

- **STEP 4:** If two or more teams are tied after Step 3 the following steps will be taken to determine the Wild Card(s):
 - A) **MOST RUNS SCORED** will be used. All pool play games will be counted. The teams with the lowest runs allowed will be awarded the remaining wild card berths.

Refer to Step 2 if there are two teams that remain tied after completing Step 4.

STEP 5: If two or more teams are tied after Step 4, coin flip.

SPECIAL NOTES:

A tie game is considered a 1/2 win and a 1/2 loss

Any forfeit will be scored 7-0
