

Varsity Overview

As I read last years (97-98) wrestling overview, it talked about Edwardsville Wrestling taking a step forward, and accomplishing goals that only a few elite Edwardsville Wrestling teams have reached. This year the 1998-99 Tigers took a step further which included the third best record (19-2) in school history. Only the realignment of regionals (Granite) held this team from meeting last years top sixteen finish. But YES, the Edwardsville wrestlers have closed the gap that has stood between them and Granite City for some years. In dual action we lost 6 matches to 8, and by a mere 40 points in individual regionals. This alone, seemingly measures the success that the young men of Edwardsville have accomplished, but it goes much further.

The Tigers earned a first ever Mascoutah Championship. They also placed better in the Mahomet- Seymour and Granite City Holiday Tournament. Team and individual accomplishments make the 1998-99 season one to never forget.

The Southwest Conference opener vs. Belleville East seemed to ignite the team as they won in a fairly lopsided match. Kids Night was a success as it brought a big crowd and a big victory vs. perennial Southwest Conference rival Belleville West. Later in January, Collinsville became a victim of the Edwardsville Wrestlers, while over 20 former Alumni wrestlers witnessed the Tigers in another onslaught. In fact the Tigers ripped off 19 wins, with losses coming only to Granite City (4th in dual state) 47-22 and Mt. Zion (ranked 3rd in state) 35-31. Post season also brought 11 wrestlers to Sectional and 3 Qualifying for State.

The success this year will be remembered forever, and the Seniors never forgotten. As I reflect back on the uniqueness of the Senior group, they not only will be remembered for their success on the mat, but their ability to lighten the mood or make you laugh. This group led by example, both by their accomplishments and their work ethic. They will be greatly missed by the Coaching Staff and fellow wrestlers.

With the loss of this outstanding Senior group, many would think rebuilding the house would be inevitable for EHS Wrestling. This may not hold true. The future also looks bright. The Tigers return 12 letterman, seven Sectional Qualifiers, 2 State Qualifiers, and 8 wrestlers with 20 + varsity wins. This is also combined with the exceptional J.V. and Freshman teams, making us very optimistic about the year 2000.

The table has been set for even another excellent season in the year 2000. Even so, we all know that more work needs to be done to reach the goals we have set; to dethrone Granite City and represent the South in the State Tournament. We must not rest on our laurels and past accomplishments, but strive to attain higher measures. This is only done with continued work both in the Weight room and Spring/Summer wrestling. Parents I encourage you to help keep your kids involved and working toward these goals. This is what I believe makes Edwardsville Wrestling special, by the continued commitment of everyone involved.

Seniors - Congratulations on a Great career. Thank you for your effort and the memories you have given the coaching staff and your parents. I hope that through wrestling we have helped you grow and develop into hard working young men, ready to challenge life's responsibilities and hardships. As for the underclassmen, think "2000", remember your goals and work hard to achieve them.

In non-conference action, the most significant victory came against an experienced Roxana team that finished in the top 4 in the state at the junior high level the previous year, 56-18. The two Tiger defeats came at the hands of consistent Missouri powers Oakville and Fort Zummwalt South.

In tournament competition the Tigers were most dominant, bringing home 1st place in the 18 team O'Fallon Freshman Tournament, along with the quickest pin and most pins award (Nathan Gibson). Thus emptying Coach Portz's wallet. The young Tigers carried their momentum into the Southwestern Conference Tournament at Belleville West by easily outdistancing 6 other teams. Individually the Tiger freshman won a total of 31 tournament championships and 89 total medals, while thundering their way to 154 pins. All outstanding and dominating accomplishments.

With the combined talent already in the EHS wrestling program, and the hundred or so young wrestlers coming up through the wrestling club the future looks bright for Tiger Wrestling. Individually, these individuals have to set their goals high. As a team, their only goal must be to reach the IHSA State Tournament with-in the years to come. These goals will not come without hard work and dedication, not only during the wrestling season, but also throughout the year. As a coach I can only hope that these young men have realized what skills are need to succeed at the next level and that they are willing to put forth the effort that is necessary to reach their individual and team goals. The future of Tiger Wrestling is in your hands, strive to be the "Best".
