



General Meeting Minutes

November 19, 2025

7:00 PM: Call to Order

Welcome/Introductions: Trina

Booster President Report: Trina

- Update on the shed at The Joe
 - Installed and turned over to the school. Will be painted when weather is better.
 - Question about possibility of Hazen teams/clubs selling concessions on weekends to people who rent the fields (e.g., I-9 Sports). Principal Cooper and AD Billotti had the same idea and will need to work out how to schedule, equitable sell opportunities to all the various Hazen groups, etc.
 - Band asked if they can use the shed during the summer camp. To be determined, as the shed gets set up and everyone is figuring out the rhythm of sharing the space.

Membership Report: Daraith

- Membership update
 - 178 total members
 - 75 Gold members
 - 36 Silver members
 - 57 General members
- Acknowledgement of teams that far exceed the 30% threshold: Girls Fast Pitch (91%), Girls Flag Football (65%), Girls Soccer and Girls Swim (each 41%)

7:20PM: Treasurer's Report: Lee

- Lee will be on vacation 11/26-12/5 and will leave checkbook with Ken Mills in event any emergency checks need to be written
- Boosters received a thank you card for the purchase and distribution of 32 backpacks to students (joint effort with the school)
- FBLA closed its Booster account and distributed funds to DECA
- Teacher & Student Support account (previously PTSA) has funds available to support classroom efforts/costs teachers may be paying out-of-pocket
 - Primarily funded through Lee's employer volunteer match hours. Rustic Orca Crafting Company (previous Booster Corporate Sponsor) also donates 15% of its Hazen related sales to this account (but is minimal)



- Mr. Cooper suggested talking to Kelly Jones about helping to fund gift card rewards for the Attendance Incentive Program
- Turkey Basket Drive - Boosters is trying to raise \$7500 to provide a \$25 grocery gift card for every basket but so far have only raised \$3000. How to get the word out?
- Husky Concessions payout from Aramark had a prior month clerical error and is reconciled/resolved

Fundraising Report: Hoyt

- Spirit wear redesign committee
 - Hope to identify parent volunteers by January to manage the effort
 - Envisioning design ideas will come from parents, students, and vendor (Ideaworks)
 - School newspaper is willing to run a poll for students to vote for favorite
 - Would roll in new design inventory by size as old items sell out
- Historically, Boosters allots exclusive access to sell a particular item (e.g., umbrellas) to a single team/group, but will allow all teams to sell these items for concessions at The Joe
- Spirit wear cost increase – Ideaworks notified that cost will increase 5-10% due to tariffs; will apply to future orders
- Spring auction update – two volunteers per group is required to help plan and execute the event
- 50/50 raffle tickets available for sale – pick up tickets from Hoyt to sell
- Volunteers needed for Poinsettia pickup (11/20) and Band Gala (12/18)
 - Knife sharpening fundraiser is also available during Poinsettia pickup
 - Hoyt will send out volunteer notice/signup as Band Gala gets closer
- UW Husky Concessions
 - Need volunteers for last game on 11/29 – contact Kim Strege
 - Need to increase pool of volunteers for future or risk losing the stand – Parent Reps should be promoting this opportunity to their teams/clubs
- Downtown Bellevue Ice Rink will donate \$3 to HBC if you purchase your tickets in-person and mention “Hazen Booster Club”. Any funds raised will go to the TSS account.
