Reaching out to ask for your help and to make sure your teams know what to do on Friday, May 2<sup>nd</sup>. The High School is undergoing construction starting this week. Buses that park along outside of the Rink entrance will head North, turn around in the North parking lot and then come back past the main entrance of the Ice Arena and head out to 80<sup>th</sup> street. No through traffic will be able to drive North past the Ice Arena entrance between 2:30-3:30pm.

What this means for you and your teams:

- Your 3pm game, please make sure you tell these two teams, to drop off by 2:30pm and park on Ideal or the frontage road. They will not be able to drive past the main entrance to turn around between 2:30-3:30pm.
- Your 4:30 game, please ask these two teams **NOT** to show up until 3:30pm. At this time, all parking will be available on the Ice Arena and School campus.

The biggest areas of concern for teams to know, is to drop off and park in the two spots highlighted on the attachment and to avoid showing between **2:30-3:30pm**.
