## **RULES**

- 1. Travesty Rule In all games played; the **20 run rule** is in effect after the fourth (4th) inning, the **15 run rule** is in effect after the fifth (5th) inning. The run spot does not count towards the travesty rule.
- 2. Teams must have **9 players** for all tournament games. Teams are allowed three pick-up players, all pick-up players must be reported to the Anchorage Sports office by 5:00pm on Friday, June 14<sup>TH</sup>.
- 3. All players must wear a shirt with a minimum of a six (6) inch number on the back. Hats are optional, if hats are worn they must be baseball hats worn with the hat bill forward. Different types of baseball hats are allowed.
- 4. There will be a 6-run spot per division difference when teams from different divisions play each other.
- 5. Batting orders are to be submitted to the home plate umpire at least five (5) minutes before game time.
- 6. A coin toss before the game will determine the home team.
- 7. Both tournaments are money tournaments and no score keepers will be provided. Home team will be the official book during all games played. If your team is unable to provide a scorekeeper you will be the visiting team. It is recommended both teams keep score during the games.
- 8. Game time is forfeit time. No grace period is permitted unless the scheduled team(s) is still participating in an earlier tournament game. All games will have a 60 minute time limit, except the championship or "if" game which will have no time limit.
- 9. The International Tie-breaker rule will be used for any games ending in a tie during regulation play.
- 10. The tournament director will furnish each team with two (2) new Worth game balls and one used Worth game ball. These will be the only balls provided for this tournament. Each team is responsible

to provide the game ball when their team is at bat. Teams may provide new or used game balls for their offensive half inning. All balls used must be a 52/300 official ASA game ball. The tournament director will have additional ASA balls available for sale upstairs. Additional game balls may be purchased for \$5 per ball.

- 11. Teams hitting home runs over the fence or foul balls out of the playing field must retrieve the balls or supply an official ASA ball to the umpire to put back in play. Umpires will not have extra game balls on their person. Umpires may begin calling strikes on the "up to bat" batter if a game ball is not put back into play promptly after one has left the playing area.
- 12. The protest committee will consist of the Tournament Director, a Senior Official, and a third person of the Tournament Director's choosing.
- 13. Infield practice is not allowed
- 14. ADA recognized Service Dogs are welcome at the Jean Cartee Softball Complex
- 15. Shelled nuts, glass bottles, and metal cleats are not allowed at the Jean Cartee Softball Complex.
- 16. Pets are not allowed at the Jean Cartee Softball Complex.
- 17. Anchorage Sports and USA Softball of Alaska rules will be used except where stated within this profile.
- 18. No entry fee refunds will be made unless the entire tournament is rained out.
- 19. Men's C teams finishing 1<sup>st</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> and Men's D teams finishing 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> and women's teams finishing 1<sup>st</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> will not be awarded money at the field; payments will be arranged from the softball office the week following the tournament. Tournament winnings will not be paid out if your tournament fee has not been paid.
- 20. NO OVERNIGHT PARKING AT THE COMPLEX.
