## Varsity Overview

When I began coaching in Edwardsville in 1992-93 at the Junior High, all I heard about was Granite City - the power of Southern Illinois. **TIMES HAVE CHANGED!!** At least a little. Although Granite City is still a wrestling power, the 2000 Tiger Wrestling Team stepped up to the plate and dethroned the perennial Southwest Conference Champs, in what was the most exciting wrestling meet I have ever witnessed. It felt great to be a part of it, as I'm sure it was for all the Wrestlers, Parents, and the many fans that came to witness the event. The excitement in the gymnasium when Jerry Greenwood put the final touch on the meet, will never be forgotten. And to believe this special event was just the start of what was a very memorable season.


Although the goal of reaching the Dual State Championships came up a little short, the year 2000 wrestling Tigers have very much to be proud of. Their Southwest Conference Championship run started very early on with an impressive win on IKWF/Alumni night vs. Belleville East. Then came the unforgettable Granite City Dual. As if that wasn't enough excitement, the very next week the Tiger wrestled a Belleville West squad, which was thought by many to be the team to beat this year. Wrestling without team Captain Josh Mercer(injury), every member of the squad reached a little bit further to help defeat the Maroons and virtually bringing the Southwest Conference Championship home to Edwardsville for the first time ever. Other team accomplishments included defeating Mt. Zion(pre-season 24th), Stanford Olympia(3rd in State-A), Roxana(pre-season 25th), Murphysboro(pre-season 25th), along with being crowned Mascoutah Tournament Champions, for the second season in a row. The Tigers also finished with a final ranking of 25th in the State according to Illinois Best Weekly.

Edwardsville had 5 regional Champions, while sending 9 individuals to the Sectional Tournament. Individually, Josh Mercer, Jacob Greco, Joe Bevis, and Jerry Greenwood matched the most ever representatives at the State Tourney by EHS. Joe Bevis placed the final touch on the Tigers season and his career, with a very spectacular and gutsy 3rd place finish at the State Tournament. Joe's 3rd place finish was the second highest in school history, and the best finish since 1974. Young wrestlers take notice of this accomplishment, and be the next Tiger wrestler to "*Make the Stand*".

This years seniors are a special group, and will be greatly missed. Not only are they the largest group of Seniors in my 4 year tenure, but they were also Freshman my first year, and are my first 4 year wrestlers. Their accomplishments in the past years are many, and the remembrance of them will be forever. I wish and expect them to use some of the same attributes that made them good wrestlers and young men, become successful professionals, adults, and parents.

Due to the large amount of Seniors that will be graduating, next years Varsity line-up will have many new faces. Who those faces are will be determined later. A lot of hard work was put into this **UNDEFEATED SEASON**, but the task of keeping EHS at this level will be just as hard. We must continue to work to higher levels, which can only be done with commitment. We have a large group of wrestlers returning from all 3 levels, and the year 2001 looks to be another good season. Work in the weight room and Spring Wrestling, or competing in another sport is a necessity for our success. Parents, I encourage you to keep your kids involved. This is what makes Edwardsville Wrestling special; the continued commitment of everyone involved.

Seniors - thanks for the great memories. Underclassmen, think about the future, remember your goals and work hard to achieve them.
