Goalie Development

- Overall very positive feedback from all coaches involved, goalies enjoyed having their own ice and enjoyed the time together.
- Some items will be adjusted moving toward next season
 - Move shooters out further for younger goalies
 - Shot to one area (glove, blocker, ect) until perfected
 - Simplify the drills
- Film
 - Better Communication with parents on expectations (PW and Bantams)
 - Not just goals or saves but video of zone entrance and goalie positioning
- Report Card
 - Have a paper record of conversation, this can go from goalie coaches to team coaches so we have communication between sessions and practices

Dryland

- A great first year of scheduled dryland sessions
 - Kids responded well and had great attendance
 - Nice for coaches to have a schedule and a plan
- Will continue to discuss ways to improve this program but very happy with year 1

Last Year Mite Full ice practices

- We have had two of the four scheduled full ice practices for last year mites
 - Good attendance
 - Will use these practices as a progression to Squirts
 - Will continue to evaluate and improve

April Plans

- District 5 meeting 4/5/2023
 - Discuss Blackout weekends and if they will happen again this season
 - Discuss leveling plans, hopefully they can give us some information on the plans so we can start discussions on our plan
 - Declare tournament dates
- Meet with other associations Hockey Directors and Schedulers
 - Looking for information on how associations work through some of the

challenges SYHA went through this season

- Discuss summer scheduling opportunities, be in front of the scheduling for swing weekends during the season

- Meet with Todd and SYRC on ice availability for the fall

- This would greatly impact SYHA and opportunities to run 3v3 on both sheets, get dynamics done earlier and potentially move tryouts up 2 weeks for PW and Bantam levels.

Overall it was a great season for SYHA, the changes made were positive and well received.

Will be curious to see parent survey responses, this will again give us the opportunity to improve on items that were possibly missed throughout the season.
