- VII. Developmental Leagues Update Joe (15 mins)
 - 1st & 2nd Grade Update
 - o 185 Total registered as of 12/12/22- 183 are active, 2 refunds
 - o 1st Grade Boys = 55
 - o 1st Grade Girls = 33
 - o 2nd Grade Boys = 55
 - o 2nd Grade Girls = 41
 - Last year we had 200 active players registered for 1st/2nd grade.

- I will probably need to run 4 clinic sessions based on these numbers. I am
 considering running these sessions at 45 minutes instead of 1 hour based on
 how the 3rd grade clinic went.

3rd Grade Wrap Up

- The season went well. I did receive some concern on the girls side regarding "team stacking." I allowed a board member to influence the placement of a few girls on the same teams, and I shouldn't have. This made for a less than ideal experience for those other teams of girls who were brand new to the game, expecting a more balanced game experience.
- I told the coaches the goal of this league is to "have fun, get better" and the coaches that I talked to after the season said these goals were met with their team. We had a great overall group of coaches for this league.
- A lot of requests that are out of the control of CAA
- o Multiple activities on Saturdays caused some teams to be short players
- Requests for different locations of practices or a set game time on Saturdays. easy for me to explain this isn't an option.

- We hope to have in time to distribute to 1st/2nd graders at the January 7th clinic.
