

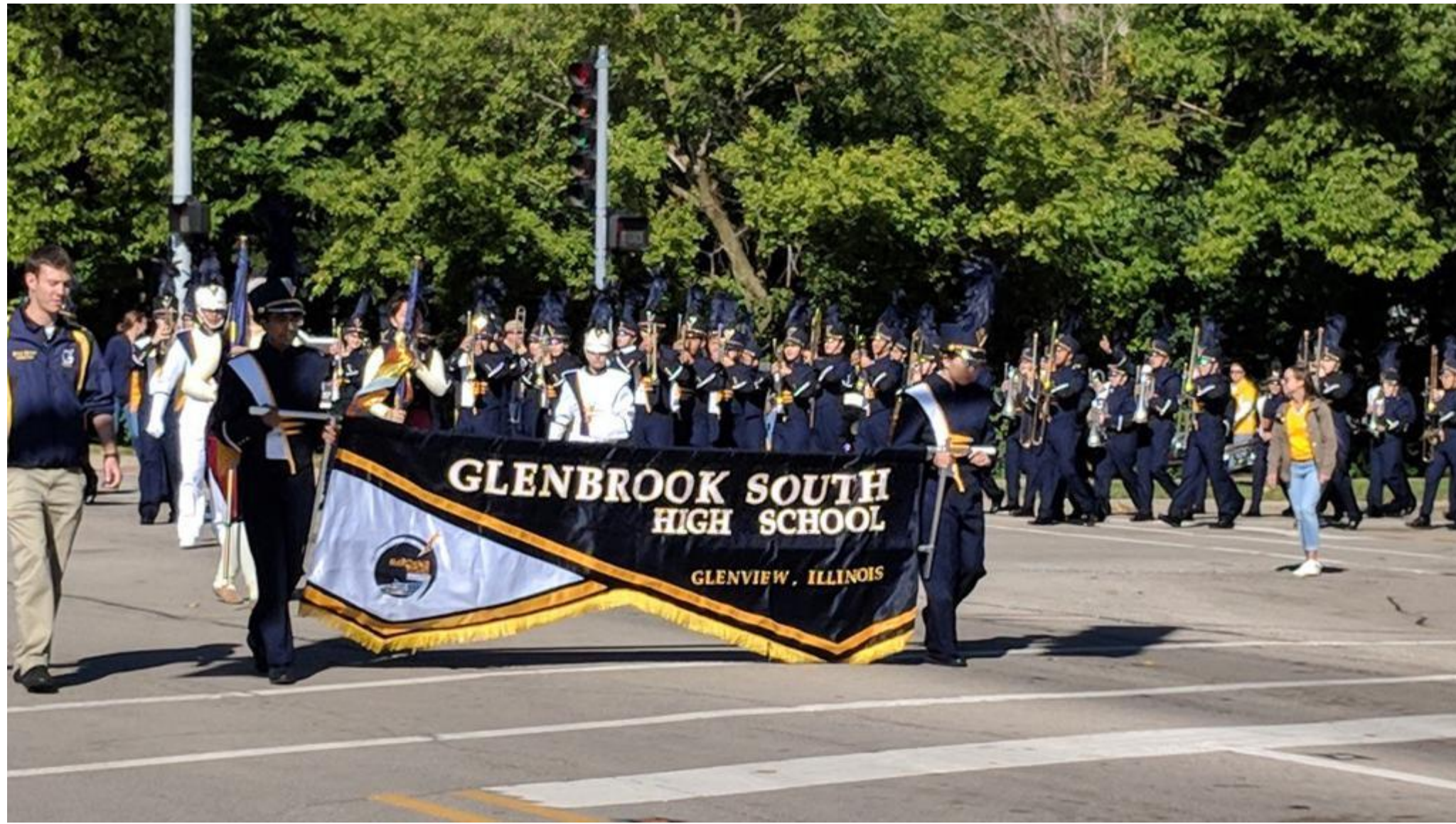

Girls Field Hockey continues to have a successful season. The Varsity is currently 8-1 with wins over Loyola (2-1) and Lake Forest Academy (3-0).

The Titans played one match this week, traveling to Antioch on Thursday night where they defeated Antioch 2-1 behind goals by Greer Bireley and Belle Teisi.

The team has a busy week coming up playing home matches on Tuesday(Elgin Academy) and Friday (St.Ignatius). The girls travel to Stevenson Thursday night.

With the season winding down, playoffs start in the middle of October. Senior night will be on October 10, vs. Highland Park.

The team's service project is raising awareness for pediatric cancer and will happen in conjunction with New Trier on October 2.







Boys Soccer

The Varsity Boys Soccer Team had an action packed week with games against several ranked opponents.

On Monday, the Titans squared off against #22-ranked ETHS in our Go Gold Game to raise money for Cal's Angels. The Titans battled the Wildkits to a 1-1 tie. Scoring the lone goal was Luis Loreda on a header off a Kyle Barda throw-in assist. The Titans were able to raise over \$200 from the game and will be making a \$750.00 donation towards pediatric cancer research.

The Titans, ETHS Wildkits, and the referees combined efforts to raise awareness for pediatric cancer.

During the game, the Titans honored 2-year-old "Mighty Matthew" who recently concluded his chemotherapy and radiation treatment at Lurie's Children Hospital. He is now cancer free!

The crowd is honoring "Mighty Matthew" and his family during the announcing of the starting line-ups.

On Thursday, the Titans hosted the #24-ranked Vikings of Niles North for Teacher Appreciation Night. The team gave the teachers quite the show by going up 3-0 in the first half. In the end, the Titans defeated the Vikings with a final score of 3-

1. Scoring for the Titans were Jimmy McMahon and Jhovany Guadarrama. Tengis Purevrentsen earned an assist. Goalkeepers Christian Noordover and Ethan Dill both had strong performances in net.

Finally, on Saturday the Titans hosted the Spartans of Glenbrook North for the Homecoming match. They were able to continue their momentum with a huge 3-1 victory. 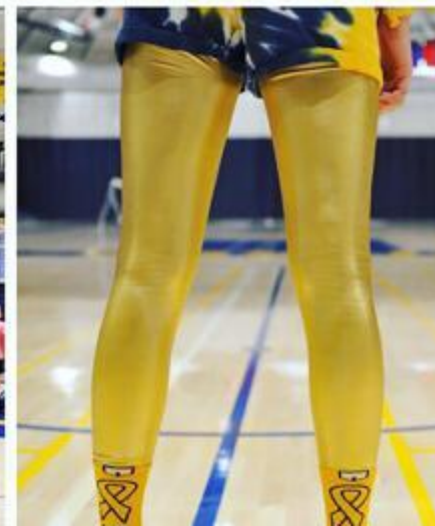


Boys Golf

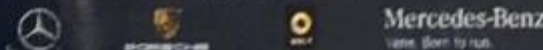
