- II. Girls Basketball update Kayla (5 mins)
 - We will continue to send a monthly newsletter! Parents seem happy with the communication!
 - Summer clinic has an amazing turn out with 30+ girls each session every time! Girls have been super receptive and coachable.

- X. 3rd grade "renegade/travel" teams Alicia (10 mins)
 - \circ $\,$ Many associations and tournaments are currently fielding 3rd grade teams
 - Historically in CAA 3rd grade teams have been allowed to form after the fall in-house season but are not allowed to compete at the same tournaments as other Chan teams.
 - Each year parents typically form 1-2 teams each at the 3rd grade level for boys and girls.
 - There is clearly a desire from the community for this. Should a fairer process be established? For example, a tryout at the end of in-house season so all kids interested have a chance to participate vs. just those who happen to know someone.
 - My point of view is if we have a more formal process and welcome these players and families in, not only will it be a fair process, but we will connect families to our travel program earlier and continue to build our community.
 - Full disclosure, I have an incoming 3rd grade daughter. :-)
 - Joe should send a note out at the beginning of the season. Indicate we have no communication with tournament teams that are formed at the end of the season.
 - Option at the end of the 3rd grade development season where they incorporate the upcoming 4th grade changes during the last week or two of the 3rd grade season.
 - Eric to send a note to Joe about these 3rd grade items. Info to communicate is on the website.
