

## ASHA 10U Half Ice/Cross Ice Rules:

Coaches Choice of: Half ice or cross ice, 3v3 or 4v4 and/or split squad.

### For 75 Minute Ice Slots

- 2 x 32 min halves (run time)
- 3 min Warm Up
- 2 min break
- Scoresheet will be kept
- Stats & records will be posted on ASHA's website

### For 60 Minute Ice Slots

- 2 x 25 min halves (run time)
- 3 Minute Warm Up
- 2 min break
- Scoresheet will be kept
- Stats & records will be posted on ASHA's website

### Penalties:

- When a penalty is called, play is blown dead after the offending team gains control. The offending player goes directly to the player bench, 1:30 penalty will apply. Face-offs will occur at the dot nearest the infraction.

### Center Dot and Goalie Crease

- Each facility, ref or coach will add a center dot
- Coaches will add a crease for each goalie

### Frozen Pucks/Pucks out of play:

- Frozen pucks and pucks out of play will result in a faceoff at the nearest of the 5 faceoff dots.

Grants for hosting 10u half ice tournaments & jamborees The State will make available \$5000 for Comp and \$10,000 for Rec. Associations hosting 10u half ice tournaments or jamborees may apply for grants for up to \$1000. The grant may cover up 1/2 of the jamborees cost (ice & refs). Monies will be distributed after the completion of the tournament/jamboree. Comp associations have until **September 15<sup>th</sup>** to apply. Rec associations have until **October 15<sup>th</sup>** to apply. Associations receiving grants will be notified prior to their respective scheduling meetings. Applications will be reviewed by the VP's of the perspective councils, VP of Player Development & State ADM Coordinator.
