- **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**
  - M. Lund motioned to approve the May meeting minutes as presented.
  - R. Sipes seconded motion, minutes approved as presented.

## **REPORTS**

- **President's Update** - *given by R. Paschke*
  - Port-a-potty should be arriving at the Middle School on Monday.
  - Talked to BJ at Pro Choice to see if he could come and give us some advice on working the fields.
- **Vice President's Report** – *given by T. Turkow*
  - Golf outing is set for August 17 at Westridge Golf Course
- **Treasurer Report** - *given by B. Paschke*
  - Will have an updated financial report and send out via email in the next week.
- **Registration Report**
  - Registrations have been added to Tee Ball and Pee Wee Tee Ball up until a few days prior to opening day.
- **League Commissioner Reports**
  - Pee Wee – Registrations were coming in up until a few days prior to start. 12U Green Team helped with the first night.
  - Tee Ball – overall opening night and went great. Some concerns with later games for young kids.
  - Majors – Discussed a concern with a league and tournament player that has only made it to one league team practice and one league game so far.
  - Machine Pitch – Had to have a discussion with one coach about the importance of practice and communications. This has improved with this coach/team.
  - Coach Pitch – Have had to address the need for rotating players with coaches.
  - Softball tournament – Tournament is full (July 5-7)
  - Boys Tournament Teams – Tournaments have started. All tournament team fees have been turned into the Treasurer.
    - Tryouts – Considering moving the 2020 team tryouts to week nights. Also considering offering two dates. Looking at July 23 and July 30.

- Boys Tournament Coordinator
  - First tournament went as well as possible given the weather. Lots of work done by team parents and board members (Gass, Paschke and Triplett) to get fields playable to get the tournament in even though it was cut short.
- Umpires – Overall umpires are doing great.
  - Minor issues: Umps need to make sure they are wearing their shirt. No phones allowed when while umpiring.

### **OLD BUSINESS/Discussion / Voting Items**

- Ball diamonds/park improvements
  - Priority one is figuring out a way to address the drainage issues.
  - Field of Dreams – project timeline has been delayed due to permitting issues.
  - Are there options for us to replace the infield dirt with different products that would handle water better?
  - Will reach out to Jesse Mallman to see what kind of recommendations he may have and if he could provide a quote.
  - Received a quote from Mosquito Squad to treat the park – Approx. \$1,100 for three applications. Will start with one application and go from there.
- Concessions
  - Bobbi Jo and Angie will be developing a Concession Stand Operations Guidebook.
- Tournament fundraising update (T. Turkow)
- Open position(s) – Boys Tournament Coordinator, Umpire Coordinator, Sponsorship Coordinator
- League tournament
  - Suggestion – Try to find a sponsor to do fireworks at the end of the tournament.

### **NEW BUSINESS/Discussion/Voting Items**

- Scheduling update – make-up games
  - Scheduling is very tight. Make-up games have been scheduled for 8:00 or at GMS and we have very little allowance for additional make-up games.
- Golf outing – August 17 at Westridge
- Red Smith Grant – application due June 10.
- Employee pay:
  - \$15/hour for lead field manager
  - \$10/hour for field workers (for hours worked)
  - \$8/hour for concessions (1<sup>st</sup> year)
  - \$9/hour for concession (2<sup>nd</sup> year)
  - Performance based raises for 3<sup>rd</sup> year and beyond.
