- **Nov 13 15 State** Hurray! Top 2 finishes in swim, and top 4 finishes in dive, at sections, qualify for state meet. You can also qualify with time cuts. More info to come as we qualify. We are in Class A this year. The state meet will start at noon.
- **Nov 17 Equipment Turn In** This is the last day that the athletes can turn in their equipment. If it is not turned in by this day, they will be put on the fine list and not able to take finals until it is taken care of.
