Covid-19 Guidelines

- 🌐 Maintain all guidelines set forth by the state.
- 🌐 Hand Sanitizer provided throughout the park.
- 🌐 Restrooms will be cleaned and sanitized often.
- 🌐 All concession staff will be required to wear mask. Operations and menu options will be changed to adhere to state guidelines.

Player/In Game Guidelines

- 🌐 All players' temps must be taken before arriving at park. Parents are responsible for making sure the kids don't arrive ill or with a fever. "When in doubt, stay home"
- 🌐 All players shall always use social distancing.
- 🌐 Players shall not participate in any hand shaking, hugging, or high-fives.
- 🌐 Player's are encouraged not to share equipment or food (with the exception of family members sharing equipment).
- 🌐 Players will not be allowed to have gum or sunflower seeds.
- 🌐 All players should sanitize their equipment before and after games.
- 🌐 Umpires will social distance themselves as much as possible when behind the plate.
- 🌐 The catcher and umpire will work together to give all parties at the plate the best safe social distancing as possible.

Coaches/In Game Guidelines

- 🌐 Coaches will monitor their own temperatures and symptoms before arriving at the park. "When in doubt, stay home"
- 🌐 Coaches will keep a face covering with them at all times and use them in the dugouts and when they can not maintain at least 6 feet of distance with others.

Parents/In Game Guidelines

- 🌐 There will be NO sitting behind back stops or dugout areas.
- 🌐 Social distancing seating always.
- 🌐 Parents must pick up all trash and place it in the trash containers closest to them.
- 🌐 After games teams must exit park immediately to allow others to enter.
