



## 2020 Health and Safety Guidelines

### *Park, Concessions, and Board of Directors*

All park visitors should self-screen. Please DO NOT visit the park if you are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms:

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills
- Repeated shaking with chills
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Diarrhea
- Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 F
- Known close contact with a person who is lab confirmed to have COVID-19

AHLL president MUST be notified immediately if a player, coach or spectator tests positive for COVID-19.

#### **Park Precautions**

Hand Sanitizer

- One per dugout,
- Two at concessions
- One per bathroom entry

Signage

- Symptoms
- Distancing
- Best health practices
- No Wall Ball

Masks available for board members

Staff must clean the bathrooms every hour.

Board members on duty should sanitize balls and equipment between games.

Scoring machine should be sanitized between uses.

ALL cages closed, including net cages.

No wall ball.

## Concessions

Limited contact

- Create lines for ordering, pick-up, and paying.
- 6 ft. markers for ordering line.
- Mark off grilling area for griller and concession workers only.

Plexiglass at each window

ONLY Concession workers will be allowed in the concession stand.

Employees should

- Wear Masks and Gloves
- Change gloves after leaving and returning to concessions, or touching face.
- Spray down picnic tables hourly, and regularly used surfaces often.

Money Handling

- Single handler
- Credit card or exact change
- Spray down picnic tables hourly, and regularly used surfaces often

No shared items of any kind at counter.

- Condiment packets instead of shared condiment bottles.
- Utensils

No sunflower seeds for sale.

## Board Members

Increase the number of board members on duty as compared to a regular season.

Grillers should be available to monitor spectators when not grilling.

DO NOT enter the concession stand.

Masks available in concession stand.

Ensure spectators in stands are social distancing.

Ensure sanitizer pumps are full, as is sanitizer spray in dugout.

Sanitize commonly used items and areas, including but not limited to:

- balls
- equipment
- gate latches,
- hand rails,
- door knobs,
- scoring machine
