Varsity - Clock will stop **ON ALL WHISTLES IN THE CSA IN THE LAST MINUTE OF EACH QUARTER,** unless there is a 10-goal differential. If the clock expires when setting up Free Position Shot, the Free Position Shot shall NOT be administered.

ALL PLAY DAY GAMES THAT HAVE 3 OR MORE GAMES ARE RUNNING CLOCK GAMES

Team time outs

Each team is permitted 2 time outs during regulation play that do not carry over in over time.

(They are not restricted to only one per quarter or half)

Each team is permitted one time out during the entire duration of over time.

The time out may be requested by the head coach or any player on the field after a goal is scored or anytime the team is in clear possession of the ball.

Successive timeouts are not permitted

If a coach wishes to use a time out to ask the officials a question, they may do so.

The opposing coach must be invited to join the conversation

The opposing coach may attend the meeting, they may choose to send an assistant coach to the meeting, or they may choose to not attend at all and continue to coach their players during the time out.

What would you say is the FIRST thing a new coach or new program needs to do? 8 responses

We are not a new team friendly operation. (That may be just how it is, not a judgement.) I would hope that a new coach had someone to help them navigate the rules, fees, ins and outs of our league. I was fortunate to have that or we would probably not have made it past the second season.

New Coach (established program) first step- come up with your goals for the season/program, then meet with various constituent parties (parents/AD/board/past varsity players) and make sure those goals align and he various groups support you and are prepared for the expectations that come with that vision. New Program fist step- if you don't have personal experience playing or coaching wlax before I would start by watching a game on youtube and heading over to usa lacrosse for some basics, then start trying to gauge interest in the new program or doing events/social media to drum up interest. Meeting with the AD to start off on the right foot with the school. Reaching out to INGLA for help and figuring out what basics you need to get the program going. If you've played before you can skip to drumming up interest- it is critical that the girls who are most interested become recruiters if you aren't working at the school.

- Board cannot change bylaws or grant exemptions
- Bylaws can be changed by proposal to bylaws committee and vote of the membership



Competition Rules / Coaches Compliance and Guidelines

- Competition rules can be found on the INGLA website under coaching documents
- Every home team must have an official scorekeeper on the sideline
 - Can't be a coach
- Coaches code of conduct. Available on USA Lacrosse website
- There is no rule regarding double-rostered players. Players that participate in Varsity or JV contests must be rostered correctly on both teams on INGLA.
- Carmel asked and was granted waiver on 50 mile rule



- We are an emerging sport starting August 1, 2025
- We are to follow IHSAA Bylaws starting August 1, 2025
- INGLA will continue to operate while in the emerging process and is responsible for running the tournament
- IHSAA can impose a penalty for any rule broken during the emerging process



Club Team vs Varsity team

Varsity team will need to follow all IHSAA rules Starting in August

Club teams during emerging. Unsure of rules right now

Once sanctioned Club teams cannot play in state tournament

Officials

IHSAA takes over officials in 2026 season

Teams are responsible for finding officials

Most schools will use an assignor



Rules to know now

- 1. Season Start date 3/10/26 End date 5/31/26
- 2. Summer has no restrictions outside of moratorium week
- 3. No contact during school year with team except during contact periods

Contact periods : 9/1-10/18 12/83/2

Can do 3/2hr sessions per week

Must be on your campus. Off site indoor rental is not currently allowed

1. Nothing allowed on Sundays

Rules to know

- 5. Coaches can't coach a travel team from August to June that has players from their own school on the team
- 6. No tryouts for a travel team during the season
- 7. Any travel team, league, clinic or camp during the school year can only have (5 -6) players from the same school on the same team or at the same clinic

- 11. Players can only play 6 quarters in a day. This doesn't apply on a playday provided the field is cleared of fans and parents. Parents and fans will need to purchase a ticket for the second game
- 12. 2 Yellow cards results in suspension for the next game.
- 13. Limit on number of games 16-18?
