#### Varsity Overview

Tonight brings the official conclusion to the 2016 – 2017 wrestling season – another successful campaign. Continuing tradition in Edwardsville Wrestling is no easy task. The 2016-2017 Tiger Wrestlers challenged themselves to reach the accomplishments of past Tiger Wrestling teams. Most EHS wrestlers put in numerous hours of off-season wrestling and weight training from March – November, giving them an opportunity to reach their goals. This is the often referred to "Journey". All though not always fun and desirable, a constant that needs to be withheld, so that we may continue to have seasons like was just witnessed.

This year's hard work and effort propelled the Tigers to another Southwest Conference Championship. This was the sixth in a row, and 9<sup>th</sup> out of the last 11 years. This year there was no sharing the Championship, and the conference was strong, as always. Depth was again one secret to the teams' success, as we used 35 wrestlers at one time or another on the Varsity level. As most seasons, with our rigorous schedule, injuries did occur, and many other wrestlers had to step up. Wrestlers were stepping in and out of the line – up all year without a blink. This has been a cornerstone of Edwardsville Wrestling for years. This year was no different, enabling us to finish the regular season 23-3 and rattle off the last 12 regular season matches. The Tigers placed a best ever 6<sup>th</sup> place in the always tough "Dvorak Tourney" and a respectable 14<sup>th</sup> place in what I believe has been the toughest "Cheesehead". Tournament that I have been to. The Tigers placed 5 in the top 8, highlighted by Luke Odom's 1<sup>st</sup> trip to the Cheesehead finals. The Tigers put everything together at the end of the season, winning their 6<sup>th</sup> straight Regional Championship, and losing a tough fought 40-19 dual vs. State Champion – Lockport (bad draw)) at the Dual Team Sectional. This year was the first time in school history that 2 wrestlers stood on the medal stand at the Individual State Tournament, as Luke Odom placed 3<sup>rd</sup> and Noah Surtin placed 5<sup>th</sup>. Baylor Montgomery and Rafael Roman were also close as they qualified for state for the 1<sup>st</sup> time.

This year's team had a heavy dose of seniors. Seven seniors all together, along with three Senior Stat girls were on the team. The seniors were busy as they all represented their team, and parents well and contributed largely to our teams Success. All the seniors seemed to enjoy the season, the comradery, and the many of trips that we are fortunate to take. It was a special group that definitely worked hard for each other. There have undoubtedly been many friendships made throughout their years and wrestling career, along with special moments that will never be forgotten. In a sport as hard as wrestling, the guys undoubtedly endure ups and downs along the way. The career is filled with learning experiences that will help with further and future endeavors. From a coaches stand point is has been a great ride. "Remember the Journey" and never forget that once you are a Tiger Wrestler, you are always a Tiger Wrestler. Wrestling on the mat may be over for some of you, but the sport and the Journey will be with you forever.

With such a talented and large group of Seniors departing, filling their spots will be no easy task. Although we are losing 2 state qualifiers and numerous lettermen, the talent that remains in the Tiger Wrestling room is enough to provide future years of excitement. Both State placers will return again next year. This year's freshman and JV teams were as dominant as they have ever been. We by no means can rest on this, as our opponents will be working hard also. Like in the past, the task can only be accomplished by hard work and dedication that past Tiger Wrestlers have endured. We need to continue to work hard and never forget what got our program to the level that it is at. The off season starts soon, and if not out for another sport – Spring/Summer wrestling and weightlifting should be attended. No matter what your grade level, let's set our goals for surpassing this year's accomplishments. Let's reach what some think is unreachable.

Seniors, thanks again for the effort and memories we all share. Stat -girls, thanks for all your hard work and dedication. Coaches – thanks for being the best staff around and dealing with me. You continue to work harder for these young men, consistently attempting to have them reach their goals. To all middle school and EWC coaches, thanks for providing me with the wealth of talent that you do each year, making my job a lot easier. Thanks parents and Booster Club members for enabling my vision for our program to come to fruition and supporting me, Edwardsville Wrestling, and your son. Edwardsville Wrestling is the culmination of many working toward one goal – success, fun, and a memorable journey. I have watched these boys develop into men, ready to take on life's challenges, responsibilities, and hardships.
