

## Concessions Policy

Revised 6-6-2018

Concessions at Lakeview Arena are volunteer run by the members of the Marquette Junior Hockey Corporation. MJHC assumed operations of the concession stand so that food and beverages would continue to be provided in the building. Without volunteers, there would be no concession services available in the arena.

Funds generated by Concessions may used to the off-set expenses of MJHC that would otherwise be passed on to our members. Every year the cost of ice, rent and administrative fees increase. For the past two years, the rise in these costs have not affected the registration fee due to the money raised through Concessions.

Concessions Pool:

1. The MJHC will solicit applications for those interested in working at the concession stand as paid employee on as needed basis, similar to the employment of timekeepers. Employees will cover shifts that remain open in the schedule after families have selected their volunteer shift s. MJH will assign employees from the concession pool to fill the open shifts. The money collected from those who chose to Opt Out will be used and cover the employee wages and associated costs.

### Concession Requirements

1. Each family must sign up for two concessions stand shifts per registered player. Learn to Skate parents must sign up for one shift. The longest shifts are 5.5 hours.
2. One weekend shift is required.
3. Sign up is done through the Lakeview Arena Concession Stand DIBS Page

4. If you have selected to Opt Out on your registration form, you do not sign up through DIBS.
5. Sign-up must be completed before the player's first practice.
6. If you are unable to fulfill your scheduled shift, you may trade with others through DIBS.
7. Check the Calendar and Concession tabs on the MJH website prior to your scheduled shift as games and practices are added and removed frequently. If no games are scheduled, you are not required to open the concession stand.
8. **Failure to show up for your assigned concession shifts will result in a \$200 fine to be paid prior to your child returning to the ice.** Extenuating circumstances will be reviewed and considered by the MJH Board.

### Concessions Opt-Out

1. You may Opt Out of concession duty by paying a fee of \$150 at the time of registration, prior to the beginning of the season.
2. Fees collected through the Opt-Out option will be used to pay for the covered shift by those in the concessions pool.

### Hours of Operation

- Monday through Friday: 4:30 p.m. to 9:00 p.m.

- Saturday: 8:00 a.m. and continuing until the completion of the last scheduled event.
- Sunday: Arrive 30 minutes prior to the first scheduled event until the completion of the last scheduled event.
- There may be times when there are no scheduled events and Concessions can close during those times.

On the registration page:

- Option 1: I understand by checking this box, I agreeing to perform concession stand duties for a minimum of two shifts, including at least one weekend shift. I must sign up for my shifts prior to the team's first scheduled practice. I understand that failure to show up for my assigned shift will result in a \$200 fine to be paid prior to the registered player's next scheduled ice time. My player will not return to the ice until my fine is paid.
- Option 2: I understand by checking this box, I Opt Out of performing concession stand duty. I agree to pay a fee of \$150 per registered player. Funds collected will be used to cover expenses and wages of Concession Pool Employees to cover two shifts during the 2018-2019 season.
